

Lat-35.7 Sunday Sep 21st 1884
Long 168.9. Very strong breeze from the N. S. M. ship on the starboard tack working to the S under short sail saw two fin backs.

Lat-34.46 Monday Sep 22nd
Long 167.57 Strong breeze from the S. M. ship on the wind under short sail a very heavy swell on broke out soap and supplied the crew. nothing been seen.

Lat-35.26 Tuesday Sep 23rd
Long 167.48 Blowing strong from the N. by S ship under topsails and courses on the starboard tack working to the S. M. nothing been seen, and nothing new to write.

Lat-35.32 Wednesday Sep 24th
Long 168.13 Moderate breezes from the N. by N. ship on the wind heading S. W. by S. nothing been seen, set up fore top mast-rigging fore gallant-rigging fore top mast-lack stay

Lat-35.58 Thursday Sep 25th
Long 168.43 Moderate breezes from the N. by N. ship on the wind trying to get to the N. W. nothing been seen broke out beef and pork.

Lat-36.7 Friday Sep 26th
Long 168.41 First and middle part a calm latter part moderate breezes from the N. E. ship on the wind N. by N. nothing been seen employed generally, set hold &c.

Lat-36.15 Saturday Sep 27th
Long 168.53 Light breezes from the N. ship cruising weather thick and rainy most of the day. nothing been seen broke out flour so ends.

Lat-35.8 Sunday Sep 28th 1884
Long 168.57 Blowing strong from the N. S. M. ship stood on opposite tack under storm sails weather thick nothing been seen so ends this day.

Lat-35.7 Monday Sep 29th
Long 168.41 First part blowing strong with heavy rain from the N. middle and latter part strong breeze from the N. S. M. weather clear saw one fin back at sun set shortened sail and wore ship heading S. so ends this day.

Lat-35.00 Tuesday Sep 30th
Long 169.16 Good breezes from the S. E. ship on the wind working to the S. W. at sun set shortened sail and wore ship heading E. N. E., saw four fin backs and birds employed generally so ends.

Lat-35.18 Wednesday Oct 1st
Long 169.41 Strong breeze from the E. S. E. first part steering N. middle and latter part on the wind nothing but birds been seen.

Lat-none Thursday Oct 2nd
Long .. Blowing a heavy gale from the E. S. E. with rain. ship bore led on the port tack weather cold, wet, and disagreeable, no observation.

Lat-36.00 Friday Oct 3rd
Long 169.52 This day first part light wind from the N. E. with a very heavy swell, heavy rain squalls through the day. wind tonight from S. E. steering N. E. by N. barometer down to 29 inches. ship rolling fearfully
