

Lat-43.25 Sunday Jan 19th 1885
Long 177.35 Good breezes from the S. ship steering
177 WSW. weather good. nothing but the
land been seen today. a long ways off.
broke out flour, killed eight sheep
and stowed down the oil in the after
hold.

Lat-43.26 Tuesday Jan 20th
Long 179.47 Good breezes from the S by E. ship
East steering SW & W. employed salting
mutton drying bone &c. saw one merchant
ship steering to the Eastward.

Lat-44.10 Wednesday Jan 21st
Long 177.18 Good breezes from the S. ship steering
SW by W. weather quite thick nothing
been seen took up the potatoes
and let them dry. so ends.

Lat-44.28 Thursday Jan 22nd
Long 177.00 Strong breezes from the SW. ship on
the wind on opposite tack nothing
except a school of porpoises been seen

Lat-44.17 Friday Jan 23rd
Long 176.40 Good breezes from the N. ship steering SW.
weather hazy, nothing been seen. took down
the upper main top sail and repaired it
nothing new to write want a whale very much.

Lat-45.09 Saturday Jan 24th
Long 174.59 First and middle part of this day blowing
strong from the NW. latter part wind
changed into the SE. very light breeze
with heavy swell ship steering SW.
saw two fin backs. so ends.

Lat-45.14 Sunday Jan 25th 1885
Long 175.03 This day first and middle part
a calm. latter part a light breeze
from the E & E. ship on the wind hea-
ding NE. saw a seal. so ends.

Monday Jan 26th
Light breezes from the NE by E. ship on
the wind working to the N. weather
came in thick and rainy to night
nothing been seen today. so ends.

Tuesday Jan 27th
This day light breezes from the E ship
on the wind working to the NE. with
very thick fog nearly all day. saw a school
of black fish and one fin back. no observation.

Lat-43.2 Wednesday Jan 28th
Long 177.28 This day strong breezes from the SW.
ship steering N by E & E. under all sail
nothing been seen except a few birds.

Lat-41.12 Thursday Jan 29th
Long 179.03 This day light breezes from the S ship
steering N. under all sail. broke out a
bag of sugar 56 lbs molasses & flour. took
up the potatoes and picked them over.

Friday Jan 30th
Strong breezes from the E by N. with
rain ship on the wind working to the
N. nothing been seen except birds,
no observation weather thick. 31st

Lat-39.42 Saturday
Light breezes from the N & E. ship
stood on opposite tack. weather quite
thick and rainy, saw spots this
morning think they were grampuses
