

Lat-54. 4 Wednesday June 3rd 1885
Long 83. 43 This day very light breeze from the N. ship steering E by S. E. S. first and middle part. latter part steering E by S. had a very pleasant day.

Lat-55. 00 Thursday June 4th
Long 82. 00 First and middle parts very light breeze from the N to E. with rain and fog. wind changed into the S about 2 P.M. ship on the Starboard tack heading E by S wind breezing weather thick barometer down to 28. 80. and every appearance of a gale.

Lat-55. 30 Friday June 5th
Long 78. 40 This day moderate breeze from the N. ship steering E by S. about 3 P.M. spoke an Italian Bark from Monterey Mexico. bound to Guayaquil Ecuador and compared longitude & latitude weather good but cloudy. also saw one other sail. they were both steering into the N.W.

Lat-57. 07 Saturday June 6th
Long 76. 40 First and middle parts of this day strong breezes from the N. ship steering E and latter part blowing strong from the same steering E.N.E. after we got an observation saw three sails steering to the N.W.

Lat-57. 15 Sunday June 7th
Long 73. 07 This day moderate breezes from the N.W. ship steering E.N.E. under all sail that is necessary. weather very thick and rainy. barometer down to 29

Lat-57. 27 Monday June 8th 1885
Long 71. 32 This day strong breezes from the E by N. weather thick and foggy ship stood on opposite tacks during the day under short-sail. made slow progress towards home these last twenty four hours. nothing new to write so ends.

Lat-57. 25 Tuesday June 9th
Long 71. 00 This day light breezes from the N.W. ship steering E by N. weather foggy but was able to get an observation broke out a new chest of tea.

Lat-57. 30 Wednesday June 10th
Long 67. 04 This day strong breezes from the N by N. ship steering E.N.E. under what sail we can carry. passed Cape Horn today according to our reckoning nothing special to write so ends.

Lat-57. 00 Thursday June 11th
Long 63. 30 First part of this day strong breezes from the N to N.W. ship steering N.E. middle part steering N.E. by N latter part the same saw a large merchant-ship steering about the same as ourselves. weather cloudy and quite cold. so ends this day.

Lat-55. 47 Friday June 12th
Long 58. 39 This day light breezes from the N.W. to N ship steering N.E. by N to N.E. by N & N. weather good. broke out bread and water wet hold. one sail in sight steering the same as ourselves.
