

Lat-25.4 Friday July 31st 1885
Long 57.3 Very light breezes from the S.W. ship
steering N.W. weather fine and very hot
employed painting, wet hold &c. saw
two sails and two steamers.

Lat-26.49 Saturday Aug 1st
Long 57.55 Very light breezes from the S. ship steering
N.W. all sail out. weather fine and hot
employed painting, and broke out flour
saw two sails, and gulf weed.

Lat-26.22 Sunday Aug 2nd
Long 58.22 First part of this day very light breeze
from the S. ship steering N.W. all sail out
middle and latter part a calm. weather
very hot. plenty of gulf weed in sight.

Lat-26.36 Monday Aug 3rd
Long 58.36 This day calms and light airs from
the S to N.E. ship steering N.W. employed
painting. weather fine and very hot
Thermometer up to 98 deg in the shade and
has been for several days one sail in
sight - also much gulf weed.

Lat-27.00 Tuesday Aug 4th
Long 59.29 Light airs from the E. ship steering N.W.
weather fine and very hot. employed
painting the spars and doing other
odd jobs about the ship nothing in sight
except gulf weed to ends this day.

Lat-27.28 Wednesday Aug 5th
Long 60.17 Very light breezes from the E ship steering
N.W. all sail out. weather fine and very hot
men employed old iron ware buckets
rice bench and some other things. put
the spars in their places. saw one sail

Lat-28.04 Thursday Aug 6th 1885
Long 61.09 Very light breezes from the E. ship
steering N.W. employed cleaning the
iron work in run and also painting
the line tubs. weather very hot
plenty of gulf weed in sight - so ends

Lat-29.02 Friday Aug 7th
Long 62.25 This day good breezes from the N.N.E. ship
steering N.W. under all sail. men
employed wetting hold and various
other jobs. saw two sails so ends.

Lat-30.16 Saturday Aug 8th
Long 64.58 Moderate breezes from the N ship on the
wind heading N.N.W. weather fine and hot
men employed doing odd jobs about the
ship cooper making a new hose tub saw
one sails.

Lat-30.54 Sunday Aug 9th
Long 65.23 This day calms and light breezes
from the W. ship steering N.N.W. wind
very light - saw two sails spoke the Italian
Barkentine Angelamaria 63 days from
Sicily bound to New York loaded with
cloth.

Lat-31.27 Monday Aug 10th
Long 65.44 This day very light breezes from
the E to S.W. ship steering N.W.
by N. weather fine and very hot
employed generally. two sails in
sight - nothing special to write
