Friday

Sep 3rd

Long 42.54 Strong breezes from the N.E. ship on the wind working to the E, employed in ships duty nothing been seen so ends.

Lat-32.37

Saturday

Sep 4th

Long 42.49 Moderate breezes from N.E. ship on the wind working to the E broke out water and employed in ships duty nothing except fish in sight so ends.

Lat-32.19

Sunday

Sep 5th

Long 40.57 Moderate breezes from the S.E. ship on opposite tacks, about 3 o'clock Mr. Beebe raised a school of sperm whales loured for them and the Starboard boat struck took the whale to the ship about dark. Waist boat store quite bad by.

Monday

Sep 6th

Long 41.00 Light breezes from the E & S.E. ship on the wind, cut in our whale this morning. Broke out flum and started the try works. weather fine nothing been seen so ends.

Lat-33.27

Tuesday

Sep 7th

Long 40.37 This day light breezes from the S.E. ship on the wind working to the N.E. finished boiling this noon the whale turned up 31 bls.

Lat-34.8

Wednesday

Sep 8th 1886

Long 39.44

First and middle parts of this day light breezes from the W latter part strong breeze from N.N.W. employed blacksmithing and various other jobs nothing been seen.

Lat-35.28

Thursday

Sep 9th

Long 37.23

Moderate breezes from the N. ship on the wind working to the N.E. employed cooping oil and other jobs saw jumpers.

Lat-36.24

Friday

Sep 10th

Long 36.2

Good breezes from the N.N.W. ship steering E.N.E. raised sperm whales at 2 P.M. going to the leeward S.E. loured for them and the Starboard boat struck took the whale along side and commenced to cut. Broke out molasses this morning.

Lat-37.25

Saturday

Sep 11th

Long 34.30

First part of this day good breezes from the N.N.W. ship steering E.N.E. middle and latter part squally thick and rainy employed boiling

Lat-38.4

Sunday

Sep 12th

Long 33.1

Strong breezes from the N.N.E. ship on the wind working to the E heavy swell on nothing been seen except one sail.

Lat-38.8

Monday

Sep 13th

Long 30.51

Strong breezes from the N.E. and heavy swell ship working to the E. broke out beef & pork cheese and packed a cask full of canned goods. nothing been seen.
