Long 25.4 This day strong breezes from the E.S.E. ship on the wind heading S. weather squally at times. men employed generally nothing in sight.

Wednesday Nov 3rd

Long 24.00 This day light breezes from the E. ship steering S by E. under all sail nothing been seen broke out flour. and slop cask.

Lat-19.32

Thursday Nov 4th

Long 23.12 This day good breezes from the E ship steering S by W. under all sail weather fine. and also comfortable. broke out slop cask and supplied the crew

Lat-22.2

Friday Nov 5th

Long 22.57 This day light breezes from the N. ship steering S by W. weather fine employed making new foot ropes nothing in sight so ends

Lat-22.52

Saturday Nov 6th

Long 22.48 This day light breezes from the E.S.E. ship steering S by W. men employed generally nothing been seen and nothing new to write

Sunday Nov 7th 1886.

Long 22.41

This day light breezes from the E.S.E. ship steering S by W under all sail weather fine and clear. saw on albatross. nothing special to write

Lat-25.42

Monday Nov 8th

Long 22.45

This day first part a calm and light air. latter part light breeze from the S ship on the wind heading E.S.E. nothing been seen so ends this day

Lat-26.47

Tuesday Nov 9th

Long 23.6

This day very strong breezes from the S.E. ship on the wind heading S.S.W nothing in sight and nothing special to write about so ends

Lat-28.45

Wednesday Nov 10th

Long 22.56

This day strong breezes from the E ship steering S under comfortable sail nothing been seen to day.

Lat-31.20

Thursday Nov 11th

Long 21.58

Strong breezes from the N.W.E. ship steering S. weather quite thick men employed making spun yarn. nothing in sight.

Friday Nov 12th

This day strong breeze from the S.W. with rain and fog all day. two sails in sight. no observation so ends this day.

Saturday Nov 13th

Lat-34.00

Long 19.36

This day light breezes from the S.W. by S ship on the wind heading S.E. by S. weather fine and clear also quite cool two sails in sight also several fin backs and albatross.
