

Lat-35.12 Sunday Nov 14th/1886
Long 17.38 Strong breeze from the S.W. ship on the wind heading S.E. weather rather squally. one sail in sight going the same way as our selves. So ends.

Lat-35.22 Monday Nov 15th
Long 16.00 This day very light breeze from the S. ship on both tacks. saw one sail and two fin backs. employed making spun yarn and various other jobs broke out four bags of flour. so ends this day

Lat-35.58 Tuesday Nov 16th
Long 16.18 This day moderate breeze from the S.E. to E. ship on the wind working to the S.E. took down the fore sail and repaired it and sent it again. broke out pork nothing been seen. so ends this day.

Lat-37.00 Wednesday Nov 17th
Long 14.51 Light breeze from the E.N.E. ship on the wind working to the S.E. weather fine. saw a number of fin backs and birds employed generally.

Lat-37.46 Thursday Nov 18th
Long 13.48 This day good breeze from the E. to E.N.E. ship stood on opposite tacks. saw several fin backs and right whale birds.

Lat-37.56 Friday Nov 19th
Long 12.10 This day strong breeze from the N.E. by E. ship on the wind working to the S.E. saw the Island of Tristan this afternoon bearing to the N. some distance off. could not see it from the deck weather thick all day.

Saturday Nov 20th/1886
This day blowing a gale from the N.E. ship on the port tack under storm sails. been thick and rainy all day. no observation

Lat-38.6 Sunday Nov 21st
Long 9.6 First part of this day a calm middle and latter part light breeze from the N ship steering E. weather rainy at times through the day. nothing in sight. heard penguins round the ship

Monday Nov 22nd
This day light breeze from the S.E. with rain and thick fog. ship steering E. saw a number of fin backs.

Lat-37.2 Tuesday Nov 23rd
Long 5.46 First part of this day thick fog and rainy. light breeze from the N. middle and latter part quite clear ship steering E.S.E. saw a number of fin backs.

Lat-37.00 Wednesday Nov 24th
Long 3.18 Light breeze from the N. weather thick most of the day ship steering S.E. by E.S.E. saw several fin backs. nothing special to write so ends.

Lat-37.5 Thursday Nov 25th
Long 1.98 This day light breeze from the N.E. ship steering S.E. by E.S.E. weather fine and clear. saw a school of black fish. and plenty of fin backs and feed also one sail steering into the N.W.

Lat-37.17 Friday Nov 26th
Long 0.396 This day light breeze from the N.E. weather fine. ship steering E.S.E. saw feed fin backs. and one sail. found the water tank rotten took it out and put in a new one.
