

Thursday Nov 3rd 1887

This day very strong breeze with heavy sea on wind from the S.W. rain and hail squalls through the day often. finished the Bow boat and put it on the cranes. nothing been seen, no observation.

Lat-42.28

Friday Nov 4th

Long 95.42 This day light-breeze from the N.W. to S.W. ship steering E.S.E. under all sail that will draw. men employed fixing the water pump &c. saw a number of fur backs, and sulphur bottoms. so ends.

Saturday Nov 5th

This day blowing a heavy gale from the N. ship steering E.S.E. under what sail we could carry. had to heave to about 5 P.M. no observation so ends.

Lat-43.4

Sunday Nov 6th

Long 100.24 The weather moderated this morning. left a very high sea on wind changed into the S.W. kept off steering E.S.E. as soon as it was prudent ship rode heavy. nothing been seen.

Lat-42.52

Monday Nov 7th

Long 101.27 This day strong breeze from the S and weather very squally ship steering E.S.E. had a heavy hail squall. nothing special to write. so ends.

Lat-42.48

Tuesday Nov 8th

Long 104.29 Strong breeze from the W. ship steering E.S.E. weather squally nothing in sight. employed breaking out water and various other things.

Lat-42.36

Wednesday Nov 9th 1887

This day blowing a heavy gale from the W. ship here to all day and nearly all night - last night the sea very high came very near closing the three Landward boats - last night but escaped without injury so ends this day.

Lat-42.1

Thursday Nov 10th

Blowing a heavy gale from the west ship here to. blowing very heavy in squalls. a very heavy sea on. broke out flour.

Lat-41.39

Friday Nov 11th

Long 107.29 This day very strong breeze from the W.S.W. very squally. made some sail about 9 A.M. and kept off steering E.S.E. ship rolls heavy moderating somewhat to night.

Lat-41.53

Saturday Nov 12th

Long 110.15 Strong breeze from the W. weather thick ship steering E.S.E. very high sea on nothing in sight.

Sunday Nov 13th

This day light-breeze from the W.N.W. with thick fog ship steering E.S.E. high sea on no observation.

Lat-42.16

Monday Nov 14th

Long 116.2 First and middle parts very light breeze from the N. weather thick latter part good breeze from the same. cleared up some ship steering E.S.E. nothing in sight. broke out 200 lbs of sugar rice and pork.
