Sep 27th 1887

This day strong breeze from the N. weather very squally. Capt. Brightman and boats crew returned about 3 P.M. having been out ever since morning came on board wet through and cold discharged Mr. Besse.

Wednesday

Sep 28th

Long 177.44 Strong breeze from the NW ship steering E by N. under all sail that will draw nothing in sight so ends this day.

Thursday

Sep 29th

Long 178.46 Strong breeze from the W. ship steering E by N. under all sail. nothing been seen killed in birds. so ends.

Lat-34.48

Friday

Sep 30th

Long 176.07 Moderate breeze from the NW ship steering E by N. weather quite good nothing in sight.

Saturday

Oct 1st

This day moderate breeze from the NW ship steering E by N. weather very squally and rainy, no observation broke out beef & pork sugar &c, saw one right whale porpoise.

Sunday

Oct 2nd

Long 170.41 Good breezes from the NW weather squally ship steering E by N. about 3 P.M. jammed with the Bark John & Wintrop. Capt. Pool came on board he is two years out 850 lbs all told

Monday

Oct 3rd

Long 169.32 Light breeze from the NW weather squally ship working to the NE. saw one bail and a few birds so ends.

Lat-34.24

Tuesday

Oct 4th 1887

Long 168.43 Strong breeze from the NW weather very squally. rainy at times through the day. nothing in sight except birds and one seal. employed in ships deck broke out four bags of flour.

Wednesday

Oct 5th

Long 168.38 Very strong breeze from the W by N. and weather very squally ship on the starboard tack working to the SW. under short-sail, saw one seal.

Lat-33.57

Thursday

Oct 6th

Long 168.27 Blowing strong from the SW ship on the starboard tack working to the S and E, saw a school of right whale porpoises so night so ends.

Lat-34.21

Friday

Oct 7th

Long 168.14 First and middle parts of this day strong breeze from the SW. first part ship on the port tack middle and latter parts on the starboard tack saw birds and some feed.

Lat-34.40

Saturday

Oct 8th

Long 168.41 Light breeze from the SE ship on the wind working to the SW. weather good employed repairing the main gallant-sail. nothing been seen we do want a whale very much.

Lat-35.00

Sunday

Oct 9th

Long 169.56 Moderate breeze from the ENE first part ship steering S. middle and latter parts on the wind heading SE. nothing been seen except a few birds so ends.
