First part of this day light breeze from the NW. middle and latter parts strong breeze. about 10 A.M. raised a lone right whale lowered the boats for him the waist boat gallied him came on board unsuccessful. we do feel badly, the whale showed a good chance. Ship Tiger in sight close to.

Nov 11th

Long 169.16

First part of this day strong breeze from the SE by W ship steering NE. middle part wind light luffed too heading SE about 1 P.M. the Tiger raised right whales and got one we saw a whale go to the windward after that and just at dark saw no more whales did not lower no chance wind very light to right and heavy swell we would like to get a whale very much indeed

Tuesday

Nov 12th

Long 169.9

Good breeze from the NW. first part steering S. middle and latter parts on the wind heading SW by W. saw three fin backs, three seals, and feed

Lat 35.31

Wednesday

Nov 13th

Long 169.24

Good breeze from the NW. ship on the wind working to the NNE. very thick and muggy saw killers in carcass two whales one the John & Winthrop. both to windward also saw a large merchant ship steering to the E. saw one cutting falls.

Lat 35.18

Thursday

Nov 10th 1887

Long 168.13

Moderate breeze from the SE by S ship on the wind working to the E. saw one fin back and any amount of gonies the air seems to be full of them.

Lat 35.27

Friday

Nov 11th

Long 167.55

Moderate breeze from the E. ship on both tacks. weather good saw a whale carcass and a large number of gonies.

Saturday

Nov 12th

Strong breeze from the ENE weather quite thick. ship on the wind working to the SE. saw three fin backs, no observation and a large number of gonies in sight.

Sunday

Nov 13th

Light breeze from the NE by N. weather thick and rainy. no observation ship on the wind heading E by S. saw five fin backs and a large number of gonies.

Monday

Nov 14th

Lat 37.24

Long 166.26

Moderate breeze from the NE. weather quite thick and muggy. ship on the wind working to the E by S. saw a number of gonies and a few black birds.

Lat 38.4

Tuesday

Nov 15th

Long 165.50

Good breeze from the NE. ship on the wind working to the SE. about 10 A.M. fore boat stern raised a lone right whale going to windward lowered the boats and the Starboard boat struck about 5 P.M. got the whale along side and made secure about 7 O'clock. P.M. the waist boat went on first but did not get fast. saw one fin back and birds opened a new cask of sugar and filled the locker.
