Wednesday, Aug. 9th 1881 Lat. 41.47 Long 36.16

the first part of the day moderate breeze from the N. the latter part clear & moderate wind hailing in to the S. the compass then has not any thing except a few merchantman - to right & heading N. by E on the port tack -

Thursday, Aug. 10th 1881

the first part of the day smoky with a moderate breeze from the S. W. the latter part smoky hailing N. west through the day - merchantman grampuses & jinkacks -

Friday, Aug. 11th 1881

the first part of the day quite a good breeze from the S. W. the latter part also a good breeze - smoky weather nothing in sight except a few grampuses - heading N. W. by N. E. W. -

Saturday, Aug. 12th 1881

the first part of the day smoky & foggy - wind from the N. S. W. the latter part moderate breeze - & plenty of tide rips lowered the boats for practice - one merchantman -

Sunday, Aug. 13th 1881

the first part of the day - wind to the S. S. W. the latter part the wind & weather the same - nothing in sight through the day in the shape of a whale -

Monday, Aug. 14th 1881

the first part of the day quite a good breeze from the S. W. standing to the southward & eastward - the latter part the same - to right heading N. W. W. wind S. W. nothing but grampuses & one merchantman - is all that has been in sight

Tuesday, Aug. 15th 1881

the first part of the day fine weather with a gentle breeze from the N. S. west - the latter part very moderate breeze to right with all sail out heading N. west. porpoises grampuses & merchantman - May we see whales before long

Wednesday, Aug. 16th 1881

the first part of the day fine weather with the breeze from the westward. the latter part wind died out steering S. S. W. - porpoises grampuses - & 2 merchantman

Thursday, Aug. 17th 1881 Lat 41.47 Long 36.16

the first part of the day very light breeze from the W. the latter part - calm - & light breeze from the N. W. - to right heading N. S. W. under short sail -

Friday, Aug. 18th 1881

the first part of the day quite a strong breeze from the N. W. & rain squalls - the latter part a strong breeze with rain squalls - heading to the N. - & westward further porpoises one steamer & 12 merchantman - steering East

Saturday, Aug. 19th 1881

the first part of the day a moderate breeze from the Eastward - the latter part the wind died away calm - then has 3 merchantman & a school of porpoises -

Sunday, Aug. 20th 1881

the first part of the day a fine breeze from the N. W. with rain squalls around there was white water & spots seen but we lost run of them - the latter part the same weather - got one porpoise - several merchantman in sight & N. S. W. -

Monday, Aug. 21th 1881

the first part of the day very fine weather & a fine breeze from the N. steering East through the day - latter part also fine - not a living thing to be seen around here - N. E. & -

Tuesday, Aug. 22th 1881

the first part of the day very moderate breezes from the N. & calm - the latter part calm nothing in sight in the shape of a whale - one merchantman the mate lowered & went him about 15 miles off -

Wednesday, Aug. 23th 1881

the first part of the day fine - wind S. W. steering S. E. the latter part the same - grampuses grampuses & porpoises is all that has been in sight

Lat 38.36.

Thursday, Aug. 24th 1881

the first part of the day fine & moderate breeze from the N. S. west - steering S. E. & E. the latter part the same steering S. by E. & E. - set up the main rigging - then has one steamer grampuses porpoises & several pieces of drift
