the first part of the day moderate & calm
clear weather nothing in sight the latter part the same
the mail went down for practice -

the first part of the day calm - the latter
part a little breeze from the S. East blackfish porpoises

Calm Friday. Oct 14th 1881
the first part of the day calm nothing
in sight - the latter part it has blown up from the
E. S. E - steering S. by W - porpoises & grampuses -

S. schools of Blackfish Saturday. Oct 15th 1881
the first part of the day a very little
breeze from E. steering S. by W. the latter calm after 4
o'clock downed for blackfish & got skunked -

Sunday. Oct 16th 1881
the first part of the day a fine breeze from the
S. west heading to the S. E. the latter part came in closely
& squally - wind S. W. -

Monday. Oct 17th 1881
the first part of the day a moderate breeze from
the S. W. heading S. E. the latter part came in closely
& heavy rain squalls. from the W. steering S. by W. -

Tuesday. Oct 18th 1881
the first part of the day calm & fine weather
the latter part a breeze from the S. W. steering to the W.
round around heading S. E. East by the wind grampuses -

Wednesday. Oct 19th 1881
the first part of the day heavy squalls
of rain. heading to the westward wind S. the latter part
a fresh breeze from S. E. heading S. W. under courses & m. T.

Thursday. Oct 20th 1881
the first part of the day quite a strong breeze from
the S. E. W. the latter part light from the S. by the wind
heading W. S. W. 2 merchantman - one bent W. & the other N. W.

the first part of the day light breeze from
the S. broke out daylight & fresh & boomed the floor - the latter
part a light breeze from the same quarter 2.30 P.M. hauled to the
floor - steering S. by S. - rainy -

Sat 4.03. Long. Saturday. Oct 22th 1881
the first part of the day moderate & clear
the latter part quite a breeze from the S. steering W. 2.
merchantman beating - to night heading W. by South.
Lat 3.52. Long 22.20

Sunday. Oct 23th 1881
the first part of the heading to the W. the
latter part heading E. S. E. squally - 2 merchantman
to night steering to the W. S. W. - wind S. -
Lat 2.57 -

Monday. Oct 24th 1881
the first part of the day a strong breeze
from the S. beating. the latter part wind S. W. steering to
the eastward - 2 merchantman -
Lat 2.22.

Tuesday. Oct 25th 1881
the first part of the day a fresh breeze from the
S. S. W. - heading S. E. the latter part the same - 2 -
merchantman bound to the W. W. - all well.

Wednesday. Oct 26th 1881
the first part of the day a strong breeze from
the S. S. W. heading to the eastward - the latter part turned
the same heading to the westward 1 finback & one merchant
set up the mizzen rigging & ran gun leavards -

Thursday. Oct 27th 1881
the first part of the day standing to the west
ward - the latter part heading S. E. wind S. S. West
S. E. E. -

Friday. Oct 28th 1881
the first part of the day a strong breeze
from the S. E. broke out broad & boomed it & opened
ground one (one cask, the latter part a fresh breeze heading S. E. -
Lat 1.02.

Sat 1.02. Long. Saturday. Oct 29th 1881
the first part of the day strong breeze from the S. S. E. clear
the latter part the same - S. W. & S.
