the fore part of the day fair wind N. W. the latter part a strong breeze from the N. - saw 1000 finbacks. took the starboard boat in & repaired one merchantman in sight -



Tuesday. Feb. 14th 1852

the fore part a strong breeze from the N. the latter part strong. A sperm whale raised its head above the water 40.32 2 boats & 4 men shot him. While down a Right whale was raised but going to the windward.

the fore part wind N. strong finished the boat the latter part strong wind N. W. -

the fore part of the day wind N. S. W. - fair the latter part the same. Nothing in sight -
