Monday, July 30th 1883

the fore part of the day a strong breeze
from the N. W. Whacks around to S. W. No
squalls hanging around. Relative to the S. on Star T

Tuesday, July 31st 1883

So closes this month unfruitful to us
without seeing a whale - nor not much hopes of
seeing any abundant here. fore part very squally.
Latter part the same wind to S. W. on diff tacks

Wednesday, Aug. 1st 1883

the fore part squalling & wind from the
S. & day squally. Latter part wind S. W. & squall
Not a living thing moving. all well

Thursday, Aug. 2nd 1883

the fore part squalling a very strong breeze
from the S. W. on different tacks. & very squally
the latter part the same not a living thing moving

Friday Aug 3rd 1883

the fore part fair weather wind S. S. W.
on port tack. Latter part wind shifted back
S. W. Not a living thing moving. all well

Bound To The Westward

Saturday Aug. 4th 1883

the fore part of the day clouds & squalls
hanging around sent down fore & palehead & repaired
it & sent again. Latter part repaired fore to mast stay
sail & sent it again. Close to the Reefs. to night wind
S. E on port tack course & to sails out. all well - " - "

Sunday, Aug. 5th 1883

the fore part of the day fine weather wind
suffering from the fore on different tacks. Not
much moving & fish. granules & a few fish - "

Monday, Aug. 6th 1883

the fore part a fine breeze from the S. E
on star tack sent the mizzen topsail & repaired it.
Latter part weather increased. after supper sent the sail
on port tack wind S. E. 2 finbacks is all.

Tuesday, Aug. 7th 1883

the fore part a strong breeze from the S. E
course S. W. sent In a topsail down to repair
Latter part wind the same course S. W. after
supper sent the topsail & came to the wind on P. T

Wednesday, Aug. 8th 1883

the fore part fair weather with a strong
breeze from the S. E. course S. W. sent S. W. &
down. & put some new clothes in it. Latter part strong
strong course the same finished the sail & sent it again
Came to on Starboard tack. - forpoices. is all. - "

Thursday, Aug 9th 1883

the fore part of the day fine breeze from
the S. E. course S. W. broke out mast. Latter part
fine course S. W. wind the same finished fore stay sail

Friday Aug. 10th 1883

the fore part fine weather wind S. E. course
S. W. covered the mizzen stay & set it up. Latter part
fine not a thing moving. Course the same.
Came to the wind on Star tack one man very sick
