the fore part of the day blowing a strong gale from the N. E. on Port tack. Latter part the same 6 p.m. now raised wind to S. E. flocks & tallers -

the fore part cloudy very light breeze from the N. W. on Star tack. a few flocks in sight. Latter part the same -

the fore part fine light breeze N. on Port tack. Latter part the same at 4.45. P.m. a whale raised from the deck in Brown & Blaney. Lowered 4 boats. L. B. Lunched the whale. cut skin in 2 more to the windward & a whale on our lee beam -

the fore part fair a few flocks. Latter part weather increasing. started the works. on sail in S. wind N. plenty of flocks

the fore part floor & Rain. weather increasing fresh gale. at 10.15. Whales raised by Lowered four boats S. B got one. Dancy we got more. Latter part cut the whale. - Rainy wind N. E. W.

the fore part thick fog & Rain. Whales raised by. No luck at 1.15. Lowered three boats S. W. & chased them but saw not near enough. Latter part Rain & blowing a N. Gale. then whaler working N. W. -
