the fore part light & squally goat island
in sight on Star tack wind S.W. Course S.E.
Latter part on Star tack wind the same goat I on
the weather beam - Jumps is all that's seen

Monday, March 17th 1884
the fore part a strong breeze & squally from
the S.W. Indifferent tack but a hour after start
to the S.B. Latter part weather moderating close to
Goat I. Sailing W. & W. N. W. Nothing but seen

Tuesday, March 18th 1884
the fore part fair weather S.E. & S.E. on
Port tack. Strong breeze in the after hole on port
side. Goat I. on our weather beam 20 miles.
Latter part finished sailing at 8 P.M. 24 hrs
not a thing but seen moving - All well

Wednesday, March 19th 1884
the fore part a good breeze from the E.S. & E
on Port tack potatoes out to dry.
Latter part wind E. & E. N. E. Goat I. & C. I.
in sight at 2.30 P.M. but fur. W. is night
under short sail - Nothing but seen -

Thursday, March 20th 1884
the fore part a strong N. N. E breeze Course
South Lead I on our weather beam 20 miles
of Curtis Rocks Port beam 20 miles off.
Latter part Course the same not a thing
moving. to work on fore to post I

Friday, March 21st 1884
the fore part light air from the N.W.
on Star tack fair squally.
Latter part the same Rain & hail not a
thing moving -

Saturday, March 22nd 1884
the fore part weather increasing wind N. & E
on Star tack. Rain. Latter part a moderate
gale with Rain wind backed in to the N. E
Not a thing but seen moving

Sunday, March 23rd 1884
the fore part fair weather on Port tack
wind S.W. Latter part on Star tack wind
the same not a thing moving

Mainsail

Monday, March 24th 1884
the fore part a strong S.W. breeze on Star
tack & squally. Working on the topmast -
Latter part squally on the same tack 1 ft & a piece
of squall. Sent the mainsail down for repairs -

Tuesday, March 25th 1884
the fore part light & squally breeze &
squalls of rain. Working on the topmast & repairing
the mainsail putting new bolt ropes on it -
Latter part a heavy squall running. Nothing but seen

Wednesday, March 26th 1884
the fore part fair with light breeze from
the S.E. Course N. N. E. Some 2:45 arising. Repairing
the main course. Latter part squally at 3 P.M.
Righted French rock to right under short sail
on Star & Tacking N. E by E 10 miles off -

Thursday, March 27th 1884
the fore part light fair weather wind S.E.
S.E. Course N. N. E & N.E. French rock close
to this morning. Some 4:45 arising. finished the
mainsail - Latter part light fair. Curtis Rocks
on our lee beam 20 miles off. Not a thing moving

lee. Latter part light fair. Nothing but seen moving
