Saturday March 29th 1884

the fore part fair weather with a strong S.E. breeze coast & in sight course S.W. Latter part light off W. to right under short sail on Star tack. good & barrie 25 miles - not a thing moving

Sunday March 30th 1884

the fore part a strong S.E. & breeze on Port tack. Latter part the same. not a thing moving. Good & on air weather quarters 25 miles off

Monday March 31st 1884

the fore part a strong E breeze coast & on sight on our weather Port 20 miles off when last seen light off W. sent cut foot Ropes out sent down Snigger to sail foot Ropes & flumish horses. Latter part overhauled the life lines & made a new netting for the fore star sail. a schooler raised at 3 P.M. on Port tack supposed to be the A. Libbs -

Ab. Ends March

Tues April 1st 1884

the fore part a strong E. & E breeze course S.W. nothing moving. Latter part weather increasing with rain - lower fore top sail good Ropes down.

Wednesday April 2nd 1884

the fore part a strong breeze from the E on Port tack. Latter part the same. new m. B.B. straps on the davits. not a thing moving

Thursday April 3rd 1884

the fore part a strong breeze from the E. on Port tack. breaking out & spread the slo's cash - Latter part overhauled crutching foot Ropes & sent down lower m. top sail. foot ropes - a school of porpoises is the only living thing that has been seen moving & to night on Star tack under short sail -

Friday April 4th 1884

the fore part light & baffled wind from the E. on Star tack. barrie with Ch. Swallow 11 knots out 740. Latter part the same wind & air

Saturday April 5th 1884

the fore part squally from the E. on Port tack. Swallow in sight & Latter part the same. not a living thing moving - killed the J.R. to Lower m. B.B. sail. nothing down seen -

Sunday April 6th 1884

the fore part fine light & E breeze on Port tack - Latter part the same. not a thing moving - I may we get a cut of oil - tall with

Monday April 7th 1884

the fore part light air & calm weather Swallow in sight. put a new seizing on fore top mast backstay, got one up & bundled it in. Latter part finished what was on deck & broke out water. not a living thing moving.

Tuesday April 8th 1884

Started for the B the fore part fair weather wind E. & E breeze & H.E. on Star tack. barrie line from Latter part the same finished the fore J.P. B. of it all. - course S.W. by W. not a living thing moving

Wednesday April 9th 1884

the fore part fine weather wind E. & W. course S. by W. Ch. Swallow in sight. broke out casks & started on snigger Rigger. Latter part seized it off & started the Hancock's porpoise is all the living thing that has been seen moving

Thursday April 10th 1884

the fore part a strong E. & S.E. breeze. finished Snigger Rigger & overhauled main foot Ropes - Latter part wind E. & S.E. course the same. not a thing moving all well -
