S. E. on Port tack & flocks in sight -
35.00 Latter part a fresh breeze took in sail on P. t.
168.10 finished down boats & sails. all well -
Thus & held fast.

Wednesday. Oct 1st 1884

the fore part a strong E. S. E. breeze on port
tack. kept off & run N. until 1 o'clock came to
the wind on Star tack. Latter part wind
35.19 E. & S. E. weather increased. not a thing to
169.40 be seen morning. - May we get some bit

Thursday. Oct 2nd 1884

the fore part blowing a heavy gale
from the E. & rain & under M. S. & P. L.
& Rain. Latter part the same.
things out of S. B

Friday. Oct 3rd 1884

the fore part gale moderating with a
heavy sea running. on Port tack. Latter part
35.00 on Star tack wind backing in to the S. E. &
170.00 S. one fth seen. not a whale. all well.

Saturday. Oct 4th 1884

the fore part strong breeze from the S. W.
35.00 course N. E. to N. W. S. & M. came to on Port
169.00 tack Latter part wind around on P. t. after fth

the fore part fine. Wind S. E. on Star tack
BB. cutting gear up & overhauled it Painted bow Boat
Painted Latter part wind N. & W. N. W. fog squalls prevail.

the fore part a fresh breeze from the
N. W. & squalls on Star tack. Latter part moderate
35.30 at 12.20 P. M. a fth came sight bound to the N.
168.32 a few fth seen through the day -

the fore part a strong breeze from the
S. W. on Star & port tack a whale on our lee beam
Supposed to be the C. W. Morgan. a few fth
in sight Latter part course N. E. not a thing

Friday. Oct 10th 1884

the fore part fine weather Wind N. W.
35.14 on port tack. Latter part the same at
168.38 sunset came around on Star tack. not any whales
2 fth & a school of Right whale porpoises

the fore part a fresh breeze from the
N. W. on Star tack Rain & fog prevail -
