Monday. Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup> 1885

the fore part a fresh gale from the S. W  
Course N. Latter part moderated to a calm  
Course N. N. W. Not any thing seen -

Tuesday. Feb. 3<sup>rd</sup> 1885

the fore part fresh breeze from the N. W  
& N. N. W. Latter part same as fore.  
Not any thing seen through the day

Wednesday. Feb. 4<sup>th</sup> 1885

the fore part a good breeze from the  
N. W. on Port tack. Latter part on different  
tacks. Not any thing seen. -

Thursday. Feb. 5<sup>th</sup> 1885

the fore part a moderate breeze wind  
N. S. W. on Port tack sent & small gumpers  
sent in bobstay stay & overhauled it -  
Latter part cutting gear up. & making Roper  
wind N. W. - light & fine weather -

Friday Feb 6<sup>th</sup> 1885

the fore part a fresh gale from  
the S. E. Course N. W. or W. hove to fore  
to mast stay. Rode to surge. Latter part  
blowing fresh. Not any thing seen. At night  
came to on Port tack under S. M. & S. S. W

Saturday Feb 7<sup>th</sup> 1885

the fore part a fresh S. E breeze & gulls  
kept off. N. W. engaged in making Spinnaker  
& sheet. Latter part fig. line -  
fore part mended fig line - Not a thing seen  
Came to wind on Port tack

Monday Feb 8<sup>th</sup> 1885

the fore part a fine breeze S. E & S. S. E  
Course N. N. W. Not a thing to be seen. Latter  
part course N. S. W. -

Tuesday. Feb. 9<sup>th</sup> 1885

the fore part fine weather with a moderate  
breeze from the E. Course N. N. W. Not a thing  
seen. Surveys fore to mast stay. making sheet  
& Spinnaker. Latter part finished surveys &  
set the stays up. Square head gumpers -

Wednesday. Feb 10<sup>th</sup> 1885

the fore part fine weather on different  
tack wind S. E & S. N. E. Not any thing seen getting  
Jibboom real stay & overhauling main real rigging  
Latter part making sheet & got the Laniard out  
stitching. -

Thursday. Feb 11<sup>th</sup> 1885

the fore part fine weather wind S. E & S  
on Port tack set up main to mast backstays  
& set two new Laniards. Set up fore rigging  
Not a living thing to be seen -

Friday. Feb. 12<sup>th</sup> 1885

the fore part fine weather wind S. E  
on Star tack. potatoes out of rigging & fore hole  
making Spinnaker & sheet. Latter part  
Not much of any thing Not a thing seen

Saturday Feb 13<sup>th</sup> 1885

the fore part cloudy. Not hole. Sent  
down S. M. topsail to repair gumpers &  
gumpers. Latter part sent on T. Sail & set up  
mizzen real rigging & hummer & mat -

Saturday Feb. 14<sup>th</sup> 1885

the fore part wind S. E fresh on Star tack  
beat Island & Curtis Rocks raised a 9 A. M. -  
Latter part on Port tack wind the same Curtis  
Rocks bare. Course N. S. W. 15. miles off. S. S. E. 25. miles
