Wednesday March 11th 1885

The fore part a fresh breeze from the S. E. on Port tack Coat I. in sight finished boiling at 11 A.M. Latter part on Star tack & started at around & washed off made a new pair of slings - plenty of fish. to big kind of S

Thursday March 12th 1885

The fore part a strong breeze from the S. E. on different tacks Coat Island in sight. Latter part same as fore Sunday in sight - & plenty of fish -

Friday March 13th 1885

The fore part blowing a moderate gale from the S. on Port tack run off to the leeward of Coat I. Latter part squalls not any thing later after supper, went to the N. W. again sun goat Island bearing S. E. 10 miles off. Not anything

Saturday March 14th 1885

The fore part blowing strong from the S. E. on Port tack. At 12 M. fore aroused on Star tack at 12 P.M. set fore & Mizzen topsail. Not any thing sun weather moderating a little looks Rainy

Sunday March 15th 1885

The fore part a fresh S. E. breeze on Port tack 2 schools of blackfish going to the S. E. Latter part strong breeze & foggy squalls. At 12.30 Curtis Rocks sun bearing N. E. 15 miles off. Under short sail heading to the S.

Monday March 16th 1885

The fore a strong breeze from the S. E. 10 on Port tack Steaming down on Star side of Coat I. Latter part Cooperine. & steering got 25.18.1/2 down Coat Island came in sight at 2.45. bearing N. E. 10 miles - Nothing but fish & mowing

Coat Island

Tuesday March 17th 1885

The fore part a strong breeze from the S. E. & squalls with a little rain Sunday in sight & Coat I. Steaming down the remainder of our oil - Latter part finished & cleared up around & washed off decks & water all on deck that is in casks

Wednesday March 18th 1885

The fore part light breeze from the S. E. baffling on different tacks. Latter part on Star tack heading to the S. Sunday in sight -

Thursday March 19th 1885

The fore part fair light air from the S. W. on Port tack at 1.30 wind falling in to the S. E. saw light Sunday in sight bearing N. W. 25 miles - Main sail down repairing it. Rattling down of S. L. Rig & straining them on topmast R. Latter part wind S. Course S. W. Main Spencer down & Condensed had a time seen through the day -

Friday March 20th 1885

The fore part a fresh breeze from the S. E. Course S. W. to S. Made goat island at day break came to wind on port tack at 6.30 A.M. Repairing main sail & ending new main Spencer. - Latter part finished & heading the Spencer - Curtis Rocks on the sea beam. S. E. stem. wind S. E.

Saturday March 21st 1885

The fore part blowing a S. E. gale Laying under m. topsail Latter part same as fore

Sunday March 22nd 1885

The fore part wind S. W. increasing Latter part a strong nothing sun on different tacks. -
