the fore part usually weather and different tacks
Latter part the same as fore had any thing seen

Tuesday Aug 3^d 1886

the fore part quite fine weather on diff tacks
Latter part same as fore. Had a thing seen from S.E. to N.

Wednesday Aug 4th 1886

the fore part very warm wind blowing between
S. & N. end different tacks. Latter part same as fore employed
in making line & sword mat. Lugs to lower m. T.

Thursday Aug 5th 1886

the fore part very equally from the S. to
on Star tack. employed in making sword mats
Latter part fine wind N.E. to W. Had any thing seen

Friday Aug 6th 1886

the fore part Day light air from the N.
on Star tack at 11.30 a.m. Whales raised by masts
Lowered at 12.30. 3 boats 1.50 & 4 masts. 2 masts
one small whale - got to ship at dark & got cutting
gear up.

Saturday Aug 7th 1886

the fore part fine wind N.E. & S.E. and the whole
& got him in about 6.30 a.m. Cleared the works & got
ready to run him out. Latter part started the works
& got the plumb up. Had any thing seen

Sunday Aug 8th 1886

the fore part a fresh breeze from the N.
on Star tack. finished boiler. Latter part stored the
stubs below. Had any thing seen. 22 bbls of oil

Monday Aug 9th 1886

the fore part calm during the fore & fore
to main stars. Latter part same as fore
Had a thing seen. - Prince H. Steaming into S.E.

Tuesday Aug 10th 1886

the fore part a fresh N.E. breeze on Star tack
broke out water meat & sugar. Latter part. Had much
going on shortened sail & wore shift making E by S.

Wednesday Aug 11th 1886

the fore part moderate breeze from the
N.E. employed in making line & sword mat. on Star
Latter part the same as fore shortened lifts fore & mid.

Thursday Aug 12th 1886

the fore part moderate & fine weather
employed in setting up head gear Boatsails back
Rigged masting of S. & N. & G. & G. & G. & G.
Latter part set up fore mast backs (cups &
fore top. S. & fore snifters & matted them a
new. - one man had a lantern fit to mast & a
very light air from S.E. to N. Had any thing seen

Friday Aug 13th 1886

the fore part very light air & calm
set up fore Rigging & noted the laniards -
Latter part set up main Rigging & noted the laniards
finished. Had any thing seen. Through the day.

Saturday Aug 14th 1886

the fore part very light air from the
S. course N.E. Leignis off fore & main Rigging
Latter part same as fore. Had a thing seen through
the day.

Sunday Aug 15th 1886

the fore part fine breeze from the S.E.
course N.E. one merchantman & a steamer seen - at
10.40 a.m. a whale seen was seen from fore & at 2. P. m
Capt went to in but it had been a long time in the water

Monday Aug 16th 1886

the fore part fine weather course N.E. 2 sails
in sight Capeed in R. Park & stage. Latter part work on
fore Rigging one more sail in sight. After supper
lowered 3 boats for Blackfish S. B. & Silver Birds
Had any thing seen
