

## Passage South

Monday Oct 11<sup>th</sup> 1886

The fore part called all hands at 8:20 a.m. & began to cut. Very light winds. Latter part finished cutting & sent the cutting gear down. Had any thing seen -

Tuesday Oct 12<sup>th</sup> 1886

The fore part fine weather & very light air from the S. E. Course S & S. by E. at 12. In whales raised. Dr. Hines & Lowndes & boats whales going N. E. & quick. Throwing out one sail seen -

Wednesday Oct 13<sup>th</sup> 1886

The fore part of the day fine weather but very warm & calm most of the day. Latter part finished dozing. & got the lead on -

Thursday Oct 14<sup>th</sup> 1886

The fore part of the day clearing up around course S. by W. wind baffling with rain squalls. Latter part washed the ship aft as far as gangway. To night wind N. course S. by W.

Friday Oct 15<sup>th</sup> 1886

The fore part a little squally from the N. E. & course S. by W. finished washing ship. Latter part cooped the oil & broke out water. Baffling winds & calm - Had any thing seen through the day

Saturday Oct 16<sup>th</sup> 1886

The fore part of the day, quite rain. Employed in cleaning out the tank & washing around a little. Latter part squally. wind all the around the south part of the compass - 1. steamer seen

Sunday Oct 17<sup>th</sup> 1886

The fore part of the day rain steady wind from all parts & calm. Latter part rain calm & a little breeze from the S. W.

Monday Oct 18<sup>th</sup> 1886

The fore part a fair breeze from the S. S. by E. on star tack. Looking over potatoes in storage. Latter part same as fore. To night calm.

## Passage South

Tuesday Oct 19<sup>th</sup> 1886

The fore part fine weather wind S. S. by W. standing on. Star tack saw 2. merchantman. picked over potatoes in the house. Latter part served the horses & finished the potatoes & broke out water.

Wednesday Oct 20<sup>th</sup> 1886

The fore part a fair breeze from the S. S. by W. on star tack. started to Rattle down star side of mt. R. Latter part very light air from S. W. on sail seen

Thursday Oct 21<sup>st</sup> 1886

The fore part about a fair breeze from the S. S. by W. on star tack. one sail seen. Latter part a little squally. & rain. finished the black staps

Friday Oct 22<sup>nd</sup> 1886

The fore part of the day calm weather looking east around. Latter part with a fresh breeze from N. W. & rain course S. S. by W. To night calm again. & very squally

Saturday Oct 23<sup>rd</sup> 1886

The fore part quite a fair breeze from the S. S. by W. on different tack. Latter part squally wind canting to the west in squalls. To night very light - heading S. S. by E.

Sunday Oct 24<sup>th</sup> 1886

The fore part a fresh breeze from the S. S. by W. on port tack a little rain. Latter part wind same to night heading S. S. by E. blackfish seen -

Monday Oct 25<sup>th</sup> 1886

The fore part a fresh breeze from the S. S. by W. Shear poles served fly gib penents & got main rigging shear poles off. Latter part wind canting a little more to E. S. S. by E. finished main & main shear poles. served feed -

Crossed the line

Tuesday Oct 26<sup>th</sup> 1886

The fore part a good breeze from the S. S. by W. steaming a course a while. sent down in. L. & up the J. R. & made new ones. Latter part work on foot rope a school of blackfish seen.
