the fore part of the day fine weather wind S. S. E. on Port tack broke in. After hole & coopered the flour 12 Cakes & the top line. Latter part finished the hole & washed off. Not any thing seen throughout

Friday Oct 29th 1886

the fore part a fine breeze from the S. S. E. on Port tack. sent up Lower main topsail foot Ropes & sent down Mizzen topsail. finished upper M. T. P. ropes. Latter part found tank leaking overhauled it & found the bottom poor & several staves foot poor bent a new mizzen topsail. & stowed it in cask - 6.54

Saturday Oct 30th 1886

the fore part a fresh breeze from the S. S. E. on Port tack clearing up in between decks where the tank was. Latter part finished to tight R. R. seen

Sunday Oct 31st 1886

the fore part a strong breeze from S. S. E. on P. T. Latter part same as fore. Not any thing seen

Monday Nov 1st 1886

the fore part quite a strong breeze from the S. S. E. on Port tack. sent down M. T. P. R. R. topsail & repaired it. Latter part making vinit & mizzen foot Ropes. a binback was seen.

the fore part a fine breeze from the S. E. on P. T. finished mizzen foot R. R. & made new fly gib. Latter part made new gib foot Ropes. Not any thing seen. wind to night E. Course S. S. E. -

the fore part a fine breeze from the E Course S. sent down fore sail foot Ropes & making new ones. Latter part wind E Course the same. finished foot Ropes

the fore part fine weather sent down upper 4 & 5 Ropes & sent up upper M. T. P. Ropes & put the mat on. Latter part finished the foot ropes fore & aft.

Saturday Nov 6th 1886

the fore part quite a fine breeze from the S. S. E. Course S. by W. mizzen in firing rigging around. Latter part sent up fore yard & lower 4 & 5 foot Ropes & 9 till Not any thing seen.

Sunday Nov 7th 1886

24.27

the fore part fine wind S. S. E. with a heavy swell from the S. R. Latter part light air. one of mizzen

Monday Nov 8th 1886

the fore part only moderate weather sent up upper 4 & 5 Ropes. getting yards ready for spinnaker. Latter part wind falling in to the S. wore ship H. C. by S

Tuesday Nov 9th 1886

26.43

the fore part a fresh breeze from the S. E. on P. T. gypped upper topsails. Latter part wind continue a little more to the E. - to night H. S. & S. by W.

Wednesday Nov 10th 1886

28.38

the fore part a fresh breeze from the E Course S. Not much gain on. Latter part sent up upper top 15 & 1 m. P. R. Not any thing seen
