Friday Nov 12th 1886

the fore part Rain wind hauled in to S. W. on Star tack. Latter part fog & rain 2 sails seen. Clearing in to the S. E.

Saturday Nov 13th 1886

the fore part first weather wind S. W. on Star tack making spungy am. 1 sail seen. Latter part same as fore. one sail to sight on sea beam. Finbacks

Sunday Nov 14th 1886

the fore part blowing fresh in squalls from the S. S. W. on Star tack. Quite a lot of birds around. Latter part saw one sail. to right wind S. S. W. —

Monday Nov 15th 1886

the fore part light winds from the S on diff tacks. one sail in sight. Latter part same as fore —

Tuesday Nov 16th 1886

the fore part moderate breeze from the E. S. E. & gradually falling around to E. on port tack. Jawsail. Latter part same as fore part. Not any thing seen down

Wednesday Nov 17th 1886

the fore part moderate breeze from the E. S. E. & H. D. on port tack plenty of birds & finbacks. Latter part same as fore. —

Thursday Nov 18th 1886

the fore part moderate breeze from the E. on diff tacks. Making spungy am. Latter part finished the spungy am. Not any thing seen. —

Friday Nov 19th 1886

the fore part Rain wind E. S. E. on port tack. Latter part fog wind E. & clearing S. E. —

Saturday Nov 20th 1886

the fore part blowing fresh from the N. E. on P. T. with Rain & fog. Juked every thing but L. In. The fore stay & Latter part Rain weather moderating a little to wind E.

Sunday Nov 21st 1886

the fore part calm with a heavy sea running fog & Rain. Latter part a light breeze from the N. E. quite a number of finbacks seen. Course E by N.

Monday Nov 22nd 1886

the fore part light air from the S. Course E. plenty Rain & fog. Latter part same as fore calm to night.

Tuesday Nov 23rd 1886

the fore part Rain & fog from the N. E. & Course E. Latter part a few finbacks seen. Killer & sulphur.

Wednesday Nov 24th 1886

the fore part fog wind N. E. & Course E. S. E. Latter part wind N. E. a few finbacks seen. —

Thursday Nov 25th 1886

the fore part fog & moderate weather course E. S. E. wind N. E. plenty of finbacks. Latter part one 1. 37th sail seen going S. W. broke out water —

Friday Nov 26th 1886

the fore part light breeze from the N. E. & E. S. E. Course E. S. E. 1 sail steaming to the Eastward. Latter part finished the water but & got it back again. —

Saturday Nov 27th 1886

the fore part calm one sail in sight. Latter part breezing up from S. Course E. S. E.

Sunday Nov 28th 1886

the fore part very light air from S. E. on Star tack. one sail seen going same as we are. Latter part a bark bearing N. E. 20 miles off. 2. 02 E. moving around down there —
