Fri 1st

Fore part strong breeze W.N.W. ship by the wind on star tack Latter part foggy wind W.N.W. ship on star tack

Lat 49-59 Lon 22-44

Sat 2nd

Fore part strong breeze W.N.W. and thick fog ship on different tack Latter part the same as fore part

Lat 49-29

Sunday 3rd

Fore part strong breeze and thick fog wind W.S.W. ship on different tack Latter part the same. see one steamer came close to us

Mon 4th

Fore part wind W.S.W. and foggy Latter part thick fog until 11 p.m. then some rain and wind hauling to N.W. ship on star tack

Lat 48-56

Tues 5th

Fore part wind N.W. some squally but no fog ship on diff star tack Latter part wind strong N.W. ship on star tack

Lat 48-40

Wed 6th

Fore part fine weather wind hauling to the N.E. course N.W. by W. Latter part fine wind light S.E. & S.W. ship by the wind

Lat 48-07 Lon 22-44

Thu 7th

Fore part strong breeze and thick fog Latter part wind S.W. and foggy ship on different tack

Fri 8th

Fore part wind W.N.W. with some rain and fog Latter part better weather wind N.W. and quite clear

Sat 9th



Fore part fine wind W.N.W. at 7 a.m. raised a school of sperm whales lowered four boats 4th mate struck and saved one got him along side at 10 a.m. got up cutting gear &c. Latter part good weather cut the head off and body in and set the watch &c.

Lat 48-19 Lon 22-41

Sunday 10th

Fore part strong breeze and rugged wind W.N.W. cut in the head Latter part blowing strong cut up the junk and put in the tank and at 8 p.m. started the works.

Mon 11th

Fore part some rain and fog wind W.N.W. boiling Latter part boiling
