Sat 27th

Fore part fine nearly calm
two sails in sight
Latter part fine light breeze
from the W.S.W. ship on port-
tack, three merchantmen in sight
Lat 36-38 Lon 36-27

Sunday 28th

Fore part fine light airs N.W.
ship by the wind on port tack
Latter part the same as fore part
Lat 37-01 Lon 37-10

Mon 29th

Fore part some squally wind
W.S.W. saw some spouts and lowered
four boats and went to them and
found them killers come on board
and gained the Bk. Wave 7 oaths
Latter part quite a breeze S.W.
been steering off E. in company with
the Wave

Tues 30th

Fore part squally wind S.W.
course E.S.E.
Latter part strong breeze
W.N.W. course E.S.E.
Lat 38-27 Lon 34-59

Wed 31st

Fore part wind N. course E. some
squally, one of the men ~~Panama~~ Panama
is off duty sick today and has been
half of the time since leaving home
Latter part fine wind N.N.E.
course E. two merchantmen in sight
Lat 38-50 Lon 32-24

Thurs 1st

Fore part fine light breeze N.W.
course E. at daylight raised
Floris bearing E. by S.
Latter part some squalls wind
light and at night calm was
five miles from Floris at sundown

Fri 2nd

Fore part wind S.W. run by
Floris and at 9 a.m. lowered a
boat and the mate went ashore
on Garro the ~~Panama~~ Pandeer and
John & Winthrop were laying off
and on with us
Latter part strong breeze W.
at 2 p.m. the boat came off and
we put off S.E.

Sat 3rd

Fore part strong breeze W. course S.E.
untill daylight then sighted Fayal
and run down the north side
Latter part light breeze from all
quarters run down the north side of
Pico and at sundown shortened
sail off the E. end of St. George
