

Sat 24th

Fore part strong breeze N.E.; not much
advoing but washing ship outside
Latter part fine weather not
much advoing

Sunday 25th

Fine weather wind light at 9 a.m.
went in and got the water boat
and got 188 bbls of water. Capt B. &
Wife went ashore at noon

Mon 26th

Calm and warm still laying
at anchor. 30 bush of potatoes come
off today. after noon the Consul
came off and shipped five men

Tues 27th

Fore part light air from off shore at
7 a.m. Capt Brightman & Wife
came off and we hove up our anchor
and left Teneriffe steering S.

Latter part light wind N.N.E. course
S. by W. two men came up from
down below (stow aways) on bent
cables and stowed them away &c

Wed 28th

Fore part wind N.E. (trades)
course S. by W.
Latter part good breeze N.E. course
S.W. by W.
Lat 25-15 Lon 15-54

October

Thu 29th

Fore part fine wind N.E. course
S.W. by W. 1/2 W. employed bracking out
sheathing boards &c.
Latter part wind and course the same
Lat 24-09 Lon 18-37

Fri 30th

Fore part quite strong breeze N.E.
course S.W. by W. 1/2 W. employed sheathing
the deck and bracking out flap casks
Latter part wind and course the same
Lat 21-18 Lon 20-19

Sat 1st

Fore part strong breeze N.E. course S.S.W.
Latter part strong trades course S.S.W.
employed sheathing the deck
Lat 19-20 Lon 20-40

Sunday 2nd

Fore part fine breeze N.E. course
S. by W. Latter part fine weather
3 p.m. then had a squall wind
hauling to E.S.E. ship by the wind
on port tack
Lat 16-07 Lon 20-03

Mon 3rd

Fore part squally and rainy, wind
from all quarters but light
Latter part wind S.E. light ship
by the wind on port tack
No Lat

Tues 4th

Fore part some rain wind S.E.
Ship by the wind on port tack
Latter part the same as fore part
Lat 14-21 Lon 20-22
