Fore part strong breeze W. course
E.S.E. Latter part the same
as fore part, see plenty finbacks
Lat 36-17 Lon 8-20

Sunday 27th

Fore part strong breeze W.
most of the time course S.E.
Latter part fine weather light
wind W.S.W. course S.E.
Lat 36-00 Lon 4-30

Mon 28th

Fore part wind N.W. course S.E. by E.
Latter part strong breeze W.N.W.
course S.E. by E.
Lat 36-40 Lon 2-09 W.

Tues 29th

Fore part strong breeze W.N.W. and
squally course S.E. by E.
Latter part strong breeze W.N.W.
course S.E. by E. until sundown then
shortened sail and heaved too
Lat 36-50 Lon 2-10 E.

Wed 30th

Fore part strong breeze W.N.W.
course S. by E. one sail in sight
Latter part the same as fore part
only the course S.E.
Lat 36-04 Lon 4-30 E.

Thu 1st

Fore part fine wind light N.W.
course E.S.E. Latter part the same
as fore part see nothing but one
sail
Lat 36-24 Lon 6-30

Fri 2nd

Fore part wind N.W. strong course E.S.E.
Latter part fine wind N. course S.E.
Lat 36-05 Lon 7-50

Sat 3rd

Fore part fine wind light from
N.W. to S.W. ship under short sail on
star-tack plenty of finbacks
Latter part the same as fore part
at night shortened sail on port tack
Lat 36-34 Lon 9-20

Sunday 4th

Fore part fine wind light N.E. at
daylight raised two right whales
lowered 4 boats but did not get any
come onboard and raised them
again lowered these boats but never
see them again
Latter part wind N.E. ship by
the wind
Lat 36-55 Lon 9-20

Mon 5th

Fore part fine wind N.E. ship by the
wind at daylight raised a right
whale lowered two boats the mate
struck and saved one got him along
side and commenced to cut
Latter part fine finished cutting
and started the rook
Lat 37-08

Tues 6th

Fore part quite strong breeze N.E.
ship on different tack boiling
Latter part the same as fore part
some squally
