

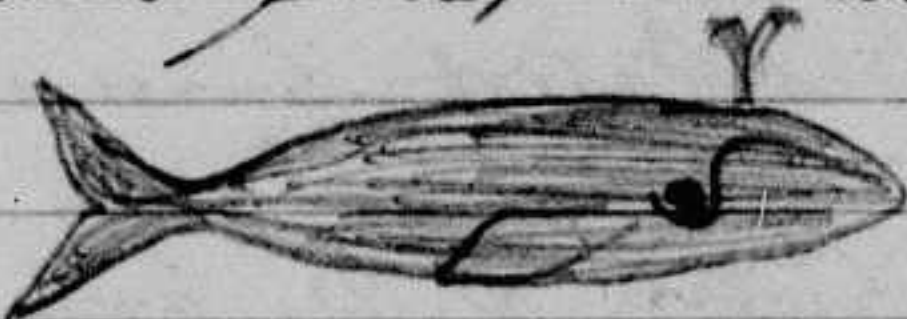
Sunday 18th

Fore part more moderate wind W.
Ship on different tack boiling
Latter part good weather raised
two right whales lowered three boats
but did not get any
Lat 37-11 Lon 9-15



Mon 19th

Fore part fine weather wind W.
raised a lone right whale lowered
three boats S.B. struck and saved
one got him alongside and hooked
on to cut. Latter part fine raised
two more whales lowered two boats
W.B. struck and saved one got him
alongside at 3 p.m. finished cutting
the first whale. boiling.

Tues 20th

Fore part quite a strong breeze N.W.
some fog and rain hooked and cut
in our whale and commenced stowing
oil. Latter part fog and some
rain stowed 97 bbls of oil & c
finished boiling the Thursday whale

Wed 21st

Lat 37-03

Fore part fine weather started the
tryworks again ship on star tack
heading S.W. boiling.

Latter part fine wind W.N.W.
at 1 p.m. raised two whales lowered
three boats S.B. struck and saved
one got him alongside at 5 p.m. boiling
Lat 37-11 Lon 9-40

Thurs 22nd

Fore part strong breeze and quite rugged
wind N.W. cooled down and cut in the
whale. Latter part blowing strong
N.W. see four right whales from off
deck but did not lower for them
boiling. Lat 37-13 Lon 10-20



Fri 23rd

Fore part strong breeze N.W. and
some fog ship on star tack
hooked and run some oil
Latter part foggy wind N.W.
stowing oil and boiling
Lat 37-25 Lon 10-35

Sat 24th

Fore part strong breeze S.W. ship on port
tack boiling
Latter part the same as fore part
boiling

Sunday 25th

Fore part light wind but quite
rugged cooled down the works
and at 8 a.m. raised whales lowered
all four boats struck three and
saved two the third the iron crew
got them along side at 10 p.m.
So ends our Christmas B.B. & S.B.

Fore part some fog wind N.E. run
about 45 bbls of oil and went to cutting
Latter part fine weather finished
cutting one whale and set the watch
Lat 37-28 Lon 10-30
