 sperm whales going to windward
 eyes out didn't lower

Sunday 8th

Fore part wind N.W. quite strong
 at 5 a.m. stered S.E. untill 8 a.m.
 then raised a school of right whales
 lowered three boats and struck two
 and saved them W.B. & S.B. got them
 along side at 4 p.m. fluck chain
 started from one and bothered untill
 most dark. strong breeze and rugged

 Latter part moderate wind the same
 cut in the other whale and started
 the works

Wed 11th

Fore part fine wind light N.W. ship
 on star-tack boiling
 Latter part the same as fore part
 Boiling

Thu 12th

Fore part fine wind W.N.W. ship
 under short sail boiling
 Latter part the same

Fri 13th

Fore part fine wind W.N.W.
 finished boiling and stered S.E. by S.
 Latter part weather and course the
 same as fore part
 Lat 37-00 Lon 13-20

Sat 14th

Fore part strong breeze W. at daylight
 come to the wind and commenced
 stowing oil. Latter part wind
 W.N.W. finished stowing oil and
 kept off S.E. by S. 8 30 W. 90 sperm
 Lat 37-24 Lon 15-17

Sunday 15th

Fore part light wind N.W. course S.E. by S.
 Latter calm most of the time
 the Mate went on board a Merchantman
 and got a few potatoes
 Lat 37-18 Lon 17-34

Mon 16th

Fore part about calm employed
 scraping bone
 Latter part light airs S.W. course
 S.E. by S. scraping bone
