Fore part calm cut the head in and started the works

Tues 28th

Fore part fine, light breeze S.W. course E. by N. boiling. Lat 27-58

Fore part squally wind S.W. S.E. beat up around the Island to the town but no landing. Lat 28-57 Lon 169-30

Fore part fine wind E.S.E. laying off and on Baskades
