Latter part more moderate with rain in squalls, wind from N to W.N.W. boiling

Sunday 30th

Fore part moderate wind W. ship on different tacks, boiling
Latter part, wind S.W. finished boiling

Mon 1st

Fore part fine wind, light from S. to E. employed blowing oil between deck
Latter part fine wind from E. to N. quite strong, gained the A. Gibbs 650

Tues 2nd

Fore part strong breeze N. with rain in squalls ship on port tack
Latter part moderate wind W. ship on port tack
Loat 31-08

Wed 3rd

Fore part fine, wind S.W. ship on different tacks, stowed our oil in after hold
Latter part fine, wind S.W. gained the Robert Morrison

Thu 4th

Fore part fine wind S.W. ship on port tack three whalers in sight
Latter part fine wind S.W. G. Island in sight gained the James Arnold

Fri 5th

Fore part fine, wind W.S.W. ship on different tacks
Latter part the same as fore part three whalers in sight and G. Island

Sat 6th

Fore part quite a strong breeze W. at 6 a.m. raised whales and lowered three boats whales going quick to windward the Robert Morrison come down from the windward and got three A. Gibbs & J. Arnold all had three boats down but got none
Latter part strong breeze W. boats got onboard at 4 p.m. gained the A. Gibbs and James Arnold, better luck next time
Mr. Mingo had one whale missed today



Sunday 7th

Fore part strong breeze W.S.W. ship on different tacks G. Island and three whalers in sight, Latter part the same as fore part

Mon 8th

Fore part calm G. Island and Sunday Island in sight and one whaler boiling
Latter part light airs from N.W. ship on different tacks

Tues 9th

Fore part strong breeze N.W. ship on different tack G. Island and Curtis Rocks in sight and three whalers
Latter part strong breeze N.W. stood up to the westward between G. Island and C. Rocks in company with the James Arnold gaining

Wed 10th

Fore part calm see one finback
Latter part calm most of the time at 2 p.m. lowered 4 boats and towed off from a reef laying S.E. 4 miles from Curtis Rocks it broke on it obtain
