

May In Port Bay of Islands

Tues 23rd

Fore part strong breeze E. S.E. course S.W. by W.
Latter part strong breeze and squally
wind E. course S.W. by W. untill 6 a.m.
then come too the wind on different back

Wed 24th

Fore part strong breeze E. at 7 a.m.
keep off S.W. by S. at 9 a.m. raised the
land and stood for it proved to be
the pious Knight keep off for Cape Bret
Latter part strong breeze E. run in
and come to anchor off the town of
Bay of Islands at 6 p.m.

Thu 25th

Fore part wind E. light and rain
got a tugboat and towed out a little way
out in the harbour where we lay with one
anchor down and 60 fathoms of cable out
Latter part some rain employed cleaning
ship outside

Fri 26th

Fore part fine wind S. light employed
braking out shooks and setting them up
Latter part fine setting up shooks

Sat 27th

Fore part fine calm most of the time
employed setting up shooks and
commenced painting ship outside
Latter part the same as fore part

Sunday 28th

Rain about all day wind light from
E. to S.W. port watch ashore for a run
Ship James Arnold come in this morning

Mon 29th

Fore part fog untill 9 a.m. employed setting
up shooks and filling water and painting ship
Latter part fine painting &c

Tues 30th

Fore part fine calm the Alaska came in
this morning employed setting up shooks
and filling water and painting ship
Latter part the same as fore part

Wed 31st

Fore part calm with land fog untill 9 a.m.
employed setting up shooks and filling water
and painting ship
Latter part the same as fore part

Thu 1st

Fore part fine calm or nearly so employed
setting up shooks and filling them with water
Latter part fine untill 6 p.m. then rain the
rest of the time

Fri 2nd

Fore part rain untill 4 a.m. then fine
the rest of the day employed setting
up shooks and working on bestays
Latter part fine calm most of the
time

Sat 3rd

Fore part fine wind light N.W. untill
11 a.m. then rain setting up shooks
Latter part rain Bks A. Gibbs and the
Canton come in today

Sunday 4th

Fore part strong breeze W. at 2 a.m. dropped
our port anchor but hoove it up again
at daylight. Latter part light wind
S.W. star watch ashore for a run
