Fore part strong breeze N. with rain squalls
Ship on different tacks G. Island in sight
Latter part blowing and raining in squalls
wind from N. to N.W. and W. sent down
the fore sail, on sail in sight (A. Gibbs)

Tues 17th

Fore part strong breeze from N.W. to W.
Ship on different tacks two sails in
sight (A. Gibbs and C.W. Morgan)
Latter part wind W.S.W. strong
some squalls, G. Island in sight to
windward, repairing fore sail

Wed 18th

Fore part fine wind light S. Ship
by the wind most of the time G. Isl
and one sail in sight to windward
Latter part the same as fore part
see one finback

Thu 19

Fore part fine wind light S.E.
Ship on port tack see one finback
and one sulphorbottom hut
fore sail and sent down M.T.G. sail
Latter part the same as fore part

Fri 20th

Fore part wind E. C. Rocks just
in sight bearing E. at 7 a.m.
raised raised sperm whales lowered
4 boats S. Boat struck and saved
one B. Boat struck and drew
Latter part wind E.N.E. cut in our
whale Ship on different tacks

Sat 21st

Fore part strong breeze E.N.E. with rain
Ship on star tack most of the time
Latter part blowing quite strong
with rain G. Island just in sight
Mined our blubber and put it in the
tank at sundown furled fore & main
top sails and wore ship

Sunday 22nd

Fore part blowing strong E.N.E. Ship
on different tacks G. Island in sight
Latter part moderating wind
E.N.E. ship on port tack

Mon 23rd

Fore part quite good weather wind
N.E. started the works and repaired
jibb C. Rocks in sight to windward
Latter part fine wind N.N.E.
Ship on different tacks two sails
in sight finished boiling our whale

Tues 24th

Fore part strong breeze N.N.E. to N. with
rain, Ship on different tacks C. Rocks
in sight and one sail (Robt. Morrison)
Latter part wind S.W. bent M.T.G. sail

Wed 25th

Fore part fine wind from S.W. to S.
Ship running up to Northward
G. Island and C. Rocks in sight one had
stowed our oil 10 bbls with an ulage
Latter part fine wind light S.E.
bundled our bone 2926 lbs
