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This day began fine wind S.W. to W.
employed cooping casks, raming ship
tried to haul the ship in along side the pier
but there was too much wind
 Latter part squally wind N.W. to W.
got off 12 casks from shore and stowed in
the ground and and it & hauled in along
side the pier.

Wed 13th

Fore part fine, wind N.W. employed
discharging oil, to be put onboard the
Bk. More Castle bound to New Bedford
 Latter part soon rain wind N.W.
 discharged all of our oil and took onboard
 some of our Bread, Flour and Meat &c.
 Put onboard the Bk. More Castle 46 cask of oil
 151^{lb} 23^{lb} per cask 254^{lb} 29 gal. W. 403 = 20 all lots
 and 8^{lb} of Shush

June 14th

More part strong breeze S.W. at 8 a.m. let go the second anchor it blowing strong, employed making out and stowing provisions in after hold and filling the ground with salt water. Latter part moderate wind S.W. discharged our bone 33 bundles 29 3/4th put it onboard of a steamer, hove up our second anchor, and now lay by Starboard anchor and 45 fathoms of cable.

3/20/54

Fine weather today wind light S.W.
employed making out the after hole and
stowing provisions and painting ship
outside

Wat 16th

Blue, and calm employed stowing the
ground in M. hatch and filling with salt
water, and Haunting Ship. & Mr. Weyman
went onshore last night and got put in jail.

Sunday 17th

Fine weather calm most of the time.
Star-boat ashore for a run.

Mon 18th

Fine weather, calm all day employed
stowing the ground and filling with salt water
and painting ship, towed the Mow Castle
outside. Per. Weyman came aboard today

Tues 19th

Fine weather calm most of the time
employed filling water and roasting bread &c.
tied down some of the pore and aft stay

Wed 20th

The More Castle sailed at 5 p.m.
Fine weather calm. employed stowing lower
hold and hauled ship in alongside the pier
and got onboard the remainder of our
provisions, coal &c and hauled off again

Thurs 21st

Good weather wind N.E. hove up our anchor and towed a little farther off shore stowed the coal, shovels & c away

Fri 22nd

Strong breeze N.E. with some rain, let go the
port anchor and now lay to 60 fathoms on star-
board anchor and 15 fathoms on port anchor, employed
slowing off after hole and filling water on shore
and fitting bobstays

Satz 23' 40

Strong breeze N.E. with rain most of the
time employed filling water, got off one
raft setting up shovels and stowing tools
