

June In Port Bay of Islands

Sunday 24th

Blowing a gale N.E. with heavy rain
no one ashore today

Mon 25th

Good weather today wind hauling to
W. hove up port anchor this morning
employed getting off a raft of water and
stowing it, and filling water on shore
and setting up bobstays

Tues 26th

Good weather wind S.W. got off a raft
of water and 4 cords of wood and
filling water ashore

Wed 27th

Good weather calm most of the day
employed putting up new F. top mast
rigging and getting off water and strong

Thu 28th

Fine weather star watch ashore
on liberty, got off a raft of water
and rattled down F. top mast rigging

Fri 29th

Fine weather wind light S.W.
got off a raft of water, potatoes,
and corn, and filling water ashore
Port watch on shore for liberty

Sat 30th

Fine wind light S.W. got off a raft of water
and sent the star watch ashore on liberty
employed stowing lower hole &c. Mr Weyman
did not make his appearance this morning

Sunday 1st

Fine wind S.W. none of the crew ashore
today Mr Weyman came onboard today

July Leave Port

Mon 2nd

Fine weather wind light S.W. Port watch
ashore on liberty, employed getting off a raft
of water and empty casks from shore

Tues 3rd

Some rain this morning wind N.W.
Mr. Weyman and a seaman Mr. D. Harrington
deserted, got two cord of wood, and some
small things from shore

Wed 4th

Fine weather light wind S.W. at 9 a.m.
hove up our anchor and towed out off shore
at 4 p.m. sent in a boat and brought
off Maurice D. Harrington
the Palmetto towed out today in the
stream

Thu 5th

Fore part fine wind from S.E. to N.E.
light, at 9 a.m. the Capt and Wife
came off and we hove up anchor made
sail and beat out
Latter part strong breeze N.E. passed
the Ninepin at 4 p.m. ship on
star tack furled upper F. top sail

Fri 6th

Fore part blowing a moderate gale N.E.
ship on star tack under lower topsails
Latter part moderate wind N.E.
ship on port tack
Boat 34-05

Sat 7th

Fore part light airs N.E. with some
rain ship on port tack
Latter part wind W. course N.N.E.
one whaler in sight
No Boat
