Fore part more moderate wind E, keep of and run around the lee side of Ono. After part quite strong breeze E, sent a boat in to the reef but could not find any passage through brought off one Kanaka but he could not understand anything landed him on the reef and stood off for the night on star-tack

Thurs 23rd

Fore part fine wind E. this morning run in to the land and Capt B. went in with trade at noon boat came off with yams &c

After part fine wind N.E. two boats went in and came off loaded with yams and one pig and a few fowl and the ship stood out for the night

Fri 24th

Fore part fine wind N.N.E. to N. at 8 a.m. two boats went in and came off at noon with yams, pigs and a few bananas &c

After part light breeze from N.N.W. ship on star-tack

Sat 25th

Fore part strong breeze S.E. ship by the wind on port tack

After part the same as fore part

Fore part strong breeze S.E. ship on port tack by the wind
