Fore part blowing strong wind S.
Ship on port tack, see two finbacks
 Latter part the same as fore part
Lat 36-12 Lon 165-48

Fri 5th

Fore part more moderate wind S.
Ship on port tack
 Latter part the same as fore part
see plenty of birds but no whales
Lat 36-02 Lon 166-46

Sat 6th

Fore part strong breeze S.S.E. at 6 a.m.
Kept off N.W. see three finbacks
 Latter part strong breeze S.S.E.
course N.W. at sundown luffed too
No Lat.

Sunday 7th

Fore part strong breeze S.E. at
7 a.m. Kept off W. plenty of birds
and one pack of feed some finbacks
 Latter part strong breeze S.E. course
W. until 4 p.m. then came too on
star-tack, nothing in sight
Lat 34-49 Lon 169-29

Mon 8th

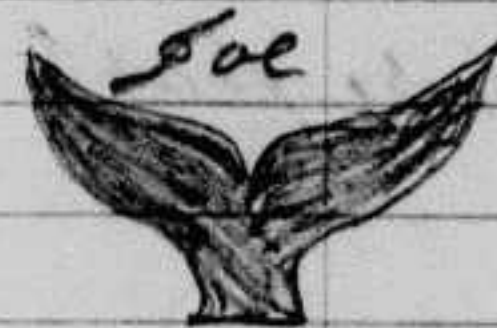
Fore part fine wind E.S.E.

 Latter part the same as fore part
see a few finbacks

Tues 9th

Fore part fine wind E.N.E. ship on
port tack see a few finbacks
 Latter part fine wind N.E. ship on
port tack at 1 p.m. raised two Right
Whales lowered 4 boats but could not
strike them got onboard at dark &c
Lat 35-03 Lon 169-26

Fore part blowing strong from the N.E.
Ship on different tacks at 8 a.m.
 Latter raised two right whales
lowered three boats but did not
see them from the boats, very rugged
 Latter part blowing a gale N.N.E.
to N. furled all sails but the top sail
and Mr. Spencer some rain

Thurs 11th

Fore part more moderate wind
from N. to N.W. ship on different
tack see one finback
 Latter part strong breeze N.W.
ship on different tacks
Lat 35-37 Lon 169-34

Fri 12th

Fore part blowing strong N.W.
with some squalls of rain
 Latter part the same as fore
see a few finbacks
Lat 35-18 Lon 169-15

Sat 13th

Fore part blowing a gale N.W.
and squally ship on port tack
 Latter part the same as fore part
see a few finbacks
Lat 35-21 Lon 169-35
