

Wed 24th

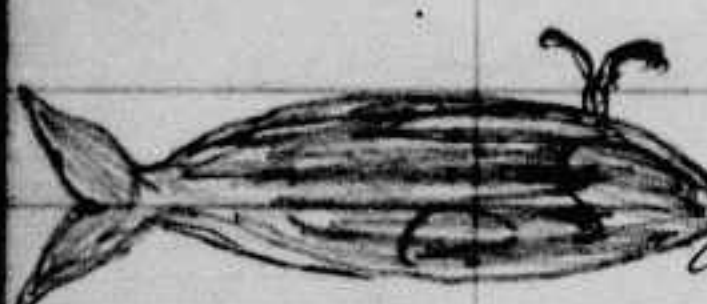


Fore part fine. Wind W. finished

get fast to them, plenty of them got
onboard at noon

Latter part fine, raised more whale
to leeward lowered all the boats and
went for them again but could not get
on to them got onboard at dark

Fore part quite a strong breeze N.N.W.
at 7 a.m. raised whales lowered the
boats S. Boat struck and saved one
got him alongside about noon

Latter part blowing strong in squalls
wind N.N.W. with rain cut in
the whale cleared away head &c

Fore part strong breeze N. with rain
and fog at 7 a.m. raised whales lowered
three boats but could not get hold of
one got onboard at 11 a.m.

until 3 a.m. then good weather
started the works

Latter part fine wind W.
ship on port tack

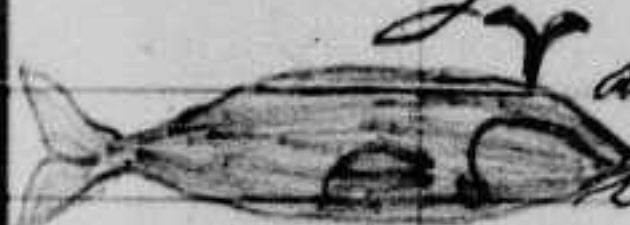
Sunday 28th



Fore part light wind S.W. with
some squalls of rain and fog
Latter part fine wind from
S.W. to S.E. at 12 m. raised
whales lowered three boats W. Boat
struck one with the darting gun
and he sunk, got the line to the
ship and hove up 150 fathoms
then the line parted to the strap
and he went for Dasseid Jones

Mon 29th



Fore part strong breeze S. at 11 a.m. raised
Sammy whales lowered three boats S. Boat struck
and saved one. Latter part strong
breeze S. and rugged got the whale
alongside and cut him in finished at
midnight

Lat 35-16 169-30

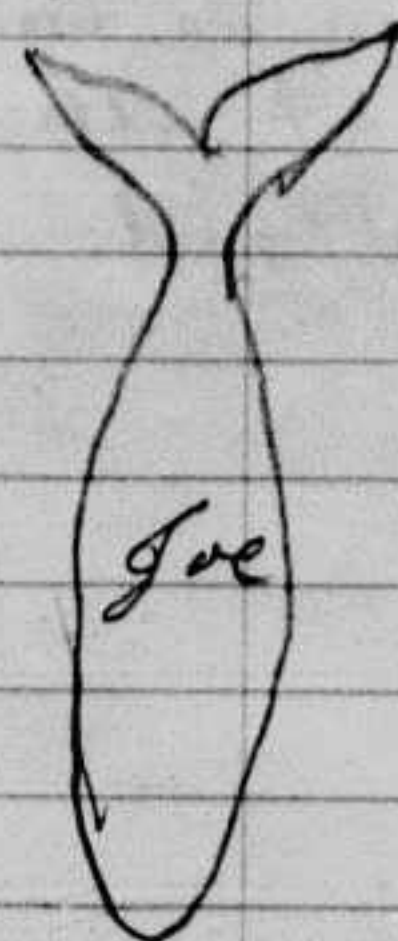
Tues 30th



Fore part quite good weather wind S.
ship on star tack, see nothing
Latter part good weather ship on port
tack raised two sails (whalers) at 4 p.m.
raised whales lowered three boats but
could not get fast, stowed 24 bbls of oil
and started the works

Wed 31st



Fore part quite a strong breeze S.W. to W.
raised whales at 5 a.m. lowered three
boat but did not strike got onboard at 10 a.m.
Latter part heavy swell, lowered again 3
boats W. Boat struck one with the darting
gun and sunk him, got the line to the
ship and saved the line but lost the whale
boiling.
