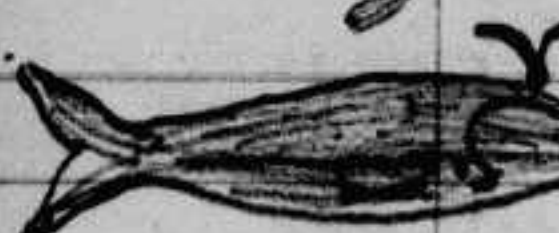


November

 Lat 35-25 159-48

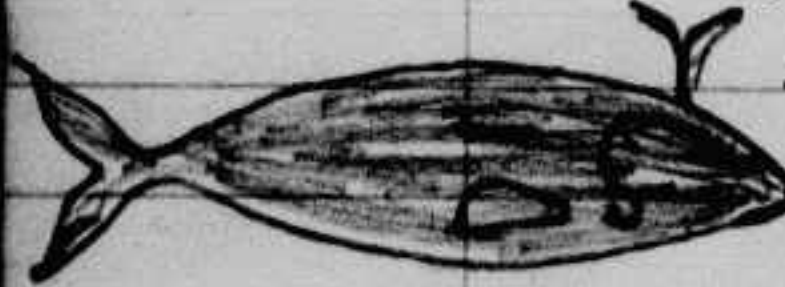
Fri 2nd



Fore part strong breeze S.W. raised
 whales and lowered three boats and while
 chasing them found our yesterday's whale
 got him alongside and hooked on
 Latter part strong breeze S.W. cut in
 the whale and started the works
 two whalers in sight one a boiling

Sat 3rd

Maedade



Fore part more moderate wind S. to S.E.
 Stowed about 57 Mls. of oil and boiling
 Latter part light wind E.S.E. at 5 p.m.
 raised whales lowered three boats
 W. Boat struck one and saved him
 Lat 35-27 159-39

Sunday 4th



Fore part light wind N.E. cut our whale
 in boiling.
 Latter part blowing a gale with
 some rain wind from N.E. to N.
 at 12-30 raised whales lowered three
 boats W. Boat struck and saved one
 got him alongside and hooked on to cut
 got one lip and had to give it up
 blowing on all the time and rugged
 Lat 35-14 159-59

Mon 5th

Fore part blowing a gale from N. to N.W.
 with rain untill 4 a.m. very rugged
 Latter part blowing strong N.W. to rugged
 to cut. scarfed the whale and let him lay
 Lat 35-35 170-07

Tues 6th

Fore part blowing strong S.W. and rugged
 cut in our whale
 Latter part strong breeze S.W. clear'd
 away the head and started the works
 No Lat.

Wed 7th

Fore part strong breeze S.W. with heavy
 swell employed boiling and breaking out
 Latter part the same as fore part
 run and stowed some oil
 Lat 35-22 159-43

Thu 8th

Fore part wind S.W. with heavy swell
 boiling
 Latter part the same as fore part
 two whalers in sight
 Lat 35-24 159-22

Fri 9th



Fore part fine wind S. light. finished
 boiling. Latter part fine wind
 S.E. raised a lone whale and lowered
 4 boats but did not see him from the
 boats
 Lat 35-19

Sat 10th



Fore part fine wind light S. to S.W.
 employed running and stowing oil
 Latter part fine wind S.W.
 at 2 p.m. raised whales lowered 4
 boats B.B. struck and saved one
 got him alongside and cut him in
 Lat 35-34 159-34
