

Wed 12th



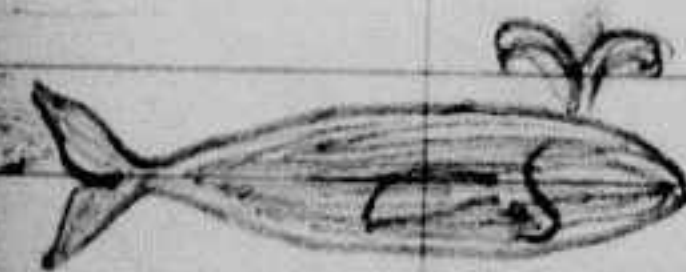
Fore part light wind W. see the Europa

Sunday 16th

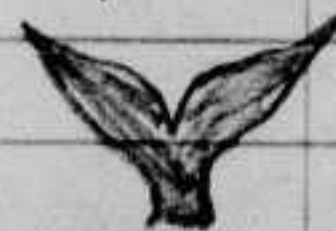
Fore part good weather wind

Fore part good weather wind N.N.E.
at 11 a.m. raised a whale going quick
to the Eastward did not lower for him
Scatter part thick and rainy wind N.
ships on different tack. finished *boiling*
this morning

Scatter part wind from N. to N.W. with
thunder and heavy rain in squalls

finished stowing oil 228 lbs. 26 28

at 6 a.m. kept off E. nothing in sight
Scatter part light breeze N. course E.
until sundown then came too
on star-tack
