Sunday 23rd

Fore part wind N.N.W. to N.W.
with rain thunder and lightning
untill 4 a.m. then smooth
Latter part wind N.N.W. to N.
with some rain course S. by E.
untill 7 p.m. then come too on port
tack, see one Sail (Merchantman)
Lat 41-01 161-23

Mon 24th

Fore part fine, wind light N.
course S. by E. see Nothing
Latter part fine light airs N.E.
course S. by E. untill sundown
Lat 41-34 161-19

Tues 25th

Fore part fine wind light S.E.
ship by the wind on port tack
Latter part wind S.S.E. squally
ship on differant tack
see several finbacks

Wed 26th

Fore part good weather wind S.
with heavy swell
Latter part light airs from N. to
N.E. course S. by E. some rain
Lat 41-46

Thu 28th

Fore part wind from E. to S.E. ship by
the wind on port tack
Latter part fine, light airs from S.E.
ship on port tack, Nothing in light
Lat 42-20 162-02

Fri 28th

Fore calm most of the time
Nothing insight today
Latter part fine light breeze N.
course S.E. repaired spanker
Lat 42-56 162-28

Sat 29th

Fore part strong breeze N. course
S.E. at 4 a.m. raised whales lowered
three boats E. Boat struck and
 saved one got him alongside and
commenced to cut
Latter part blowing a gale from
N. with rain finished cutting &c
Lat 44-06 161-27

Sunday 30th

Fore part blowing a gale with
rain untill 4 a.m. wind from
N. to N.W. with heavy swell
Latter part wind light N.W.
ship on port tack
Lat 44-28 160-58

Mon 31st

Fore part strong breeze N.W. with squalls of
rain started the work
Latter part the same as fore part
evening

Lat 44-31 Lon 160-26
