

In Port Bay of Islands

Fri 18th

Fine part fine, employed sending up
R. J. Gallant mast, yards, and setting up
rigging, painting and taring down
Latter part the same

Sat 19th

Fine part fine wind light S.E. to E.
employed taring down a fitting rigging
Latter part the same as fore part

Sunday 20th

the Swallow came in today (Sat)
This day fine quite a strong breeze
S.E. Star - watch ashore for a run

Mon 21st

This day begins with a strong breeze
S.E. with some squalls of rain
employed breaking out after hole
Latter part fine, got a raft of casks
ashore for water and stowed off part of
the after hole. the Bk Triton sailed today

Tues 22nd

This day begins fine and calm
employed stowing after hole and filling
with salt water
Latter part fine stowed meat in
after hole &c

Wed 23rd

Fine today, got off a raft of water
and broke out 78 bbls. of whale oil
to discharge
Latter part fine employed painting
and caltaring ship outside

Thurs 24th

Fine part fine, employed getting a
raft of water and getting the bone
ready to discharge
Latter part some rain

Fri 25th

Fine today at 7 a.m. the steamer came
alongside and got our bone, 106 bundles, 2120 lbs
more or less and 9 casks of W. oil about 60 lbs.
got off a raft of water, put hole &c

Sat 26th

Good weather today, got off a raft of water
and stowed off the after hole. Washed off &c

Sunday 27th

Some showery in the morning but fine
the most of the day, Port watch ashore
for a run

Mon 28th

Fine today employed breaking out shunks
and setting them up and stowing bread
and flour between decks, got off 65 bags
of bread from shore, and filling water

Tues 29th

Fine weather today, got off a raft of
water and 12 bags of bread from shore
and broke out and stowed up between
decks generally

Wed 30th

Fine today, got off a raft of water and
4 cord of wood Star - watch ashore on
liberty

Thurs 1st

Fine today, got off a raft of water
and discharged three casks of W. oil
towed it alongside the steamer 15 lbs more
or less, Port watch onshore on liberty
