

May In Port Bay of Islands

Fri 2nd

Fine today with quite a strong breeze S. employed filling water and painting some star-watch ashore on liberty. George Brown was arrested today and put in jail for stealing a boat from shore to come off to the ship

Sat 3rd

Fine today calm most of the time got off a raft of water &c. Port watch ashore on liberty

Sunday 4th

Fine today, star-watch ashore for a run

Mon 5th

Fine weather, filled the last of our water and got it off and got ready for sea generally. George Brown came off aboard today

Tues 6th

Fine today. Wind E. to N.E. got off our potatoes 24 bags and got ready for sea but head wind and tide prevented

Wed 7th

Fine today but calm. sent a boat after pippes. at 3 p.m. Captain and Wife came onboard. Hove up our anchor and moved off shore and dropped anchor again for the night, some rain

Leave Port

Thu 8th

Fore part light breeze W. at 6 a.m. Hove up our anchor and bid the Bay of Islands good bye. Latter part quite a strong breeze W.S.W. course N.E.

Fri 9th

Fore part strong breeze from S.W. to S. course N.E. Latter part strong breeze from S. to E.S.E. course N.E. Shortened sail at dark. Lat 32-30 Lon 177-30

Sat 10th

Fore part more moderate wind E.S.E. ship by the wind on star-tack. Latter part the same as fore part. Lat 32-49 Lon 180-00

Sunday 11th

Fare part strong breeze S.E. at 7 a.m. Kept off N. Latter part strong breeze S.E. course N. until sundown. Lat 32-5 Lon 180-00

Mon 12th

Fore part strong breeze S.E. ship by the wind on star-tack. Latter part the same as fore part. Lat 31-18 Lon 179-25 W.

Tues 13th

Fore part strong breeze S.E. ship by the wind on star-tack at 9 a.m. Raised Burt's Rocks ahead. Latter part strong breeze S.E. run off the lee side of the Rocks and at sundown wore ship to leeward of Goat Island 5 miles off
