Fore part fine and calm most
of the time course W.
Latter part the same as fore part
stowed some of our oil forward

Sat 21st

Fore part good weather wind
S.E. course W. by S.
Latter part wind E.S.E. course
W by S. stowed the last of the
oil in after hold 118 Wb. 3438

Sunday 22nd

Fore part wind S.E. course
S.W. by W. see some humpbacks
Latter part wind E.S.E.
Ship on port tack
Lat 24-37 175 19

Mon 23rd

Fore part strong breeze E. and squally
Ship by the wind on port tack
Latter part the same as fore part
wet hole and washed off 800
Lat 25-25 Lon 175-24

Tues 24th

Fore part blowing strong N.E. ship
on port tack under lower M.S. sail
rain most of the time
Latter part strong breeze N. with
rain No Lat.

Wed 25th

Fore part wind N. to N.W. with
some rain in squalls
Latter part light winds from
all quarters with heavy rain
No Lat.

Thurs 26th

Fore part blowing a gale S.S.E. and
squally, furled fore top sail fitted
try works ship on port tack
Latter part blowing heavy
S.S.E. with plenty of rain
No Lat.

Fri 27th

Fore part blowing strong S.S.E.
Ship on port tack under lower
M. top sail. see one American
steamer. Latter part strong
breeze S.S.E. wore ship at noon
made some sail
