Fore part light air from E. to N.E.
ship on different tack. Savage Island in sight
 Latter part light air E. got up within
 4 or 5 miles of the land at sundown
 two canoes came off with a few things

Tues 22nd

Fore part quite a strong breeze S.S.E.
 Captain and Wife went in but could
 not land (so much surf) got quite
 a lot of brown stuff yams and
 bananas and one pig, and shipped
 three Natives and at sundown
 put out to sea on port tack. wind
 S.S.E.

Wed 23rd

Fore part wind S. ship on
 star-tack
 Latter part wind S.S.W. ship
 on star-tack. see two humpbacks
 Lat 19-21 Lon 171 38

Thur 24th

Fore part wind S.S.W. ship on
 star tack
 Latter part the same as fore part
 were ship at sundown
 Lat 19-37 Lon 170-58

Fri 25th

Fore part fine. Wind S. to S.E.
 course S.S.W. when we can head it
 Latter part fine wind S.E.
 course S.S.W. employed
 rattling down Main rigging
 Lat 20-11 Lon 171-50

Sat 26th

Fore part fine wind E.S.E.
 course S.W. by W.
 Latter part fine. Wind E. to E.N.E.
 course S.W. by W. repaired Mizen
 top sail and finished rattling and
 taring one side of M. rigging
 Lat 21-30 Lon 172-39

Sunday 27th

Fore part fine. Wind from N. course
 S. until 7 a.m. then S.W.
 Latter part fine. Wind N. course
 S.W. until 2 p.m. then S. by W.
 Lat 22-38 Lon 174-02

Mon 28th

Fore part light air N.W.
 course S. by W.
 Latter part fine air from N.W.
 to W. ship by the wind on star-
 tack repaired Spunkies
 Lat 23 25 Lon 173-58

Tues 29th

Fore part fine wind light from
 all quarters course S.W.
 Latter part the same as fore part
 finished rattling M. rigging
 Lat 23-37 Lon 174-18

Wed 30th

Fore part light wind from N.
 to N.E. course S.W. by W.
 Latter part a little rain with
 air from the eastward course
 S.W. by W. rattled one side of mizen
 rigging No Lat
