Fore part strong breeze S.W. ship on different tack
 Latter part strong breeze S.W. to S. some squally Norfolk Island insight

Sat 23rd

Fore part more moderate wind from W.S.W. to S. ship beating to windward
 Latter part the same as fore part Norfolk Island about 10 miles off at sundown bearing S.

Sunday 24th

Fore part good weather wind S.E. ship on different tack
 Latter part the same as fore part beating to the windward up to the Island at sundown was 5 miles from land

Mon 25th

Fore part calm. Captain and Wife went ashore
 Latter part calm. boat came off at sundown with letters

Tues 26th

Fore part light air from N.E. ship standing in towards Cascade
 Latter part calm most of the time a boat came off and got one off the new boats and five bars

Wed 27th

This morning went around to the town sent in two boats wind N. light
 This afternoon got off two boat loads of game and potatoes, the Bk. Swallow arrived here today 30 lbs. since leaving the Bay of Islands

Thurs 28th

Fine weather wind N.N.E. to N.W. light got off five boat loads of game and potatoes
 Latter part calm.

Fri 29th

Fore part fine light breeze N. to N.E. went in to Cascade and got off two casks of wood. Latter part fine wind N.E. light got off one load of game and pumpkins

Sat 30th

Fore part quite a strong breeze N.E. to N. Starboard watch went on shore for liberty
 Latter part wind N. ship laying off and on Bk. A. Gibbs came to day

Sunday 31st

Fore part strong breeze N. sent the boat in for the watch but too rugged to land
 Latter part the same as fore part

Mon 1st

Fore part fine wind N.N.W. light went around to the town and got the watch off and the Port watch went on shore for liberty got off some potatoes
 Latter part fine got off some game and stood off for the night

Tues 2nd

Fore part fine wind N.N.W. ship laying off and on
 Latter part the same as fore part no boat went ashore today

Wed 3rd

Fore part strong breeze N.W. until 11 a.m. then squally wind backing S.W. with some rain. The boat went in and the Port watch came on board
 Latter part wind S.W. ship laying off and on
