Fore part wind W.N.W. until 8 a.m.
then had a squall of rain with the
wind S.W. course E. by S.
Latter part wind S.W. quite strong
ships by the wind on star-tack
see two finbacks today

Mon 17th

Fore part strong breeze S.W. and squally
ships by the wind on star-tack
Latter part the same as fore part
see one finback today
Lat 37-25 Lon 163-35

Tues 18th

Fore part more moderate but
swoaky wind S.W. ship on star-tack
Latter part fine wind S.W. light
ships on star-tack see nothing
Lat 38-08 Lon 162-48

Wed 19th

Fore part fine, wind light of ship
on star-tack
Latter part nearly calm. sent down
and repaired main sail, see three
finbacks
Lat 38-24 Lon 162-19

Thu 20th

Fore part calm set up M. J. Gallant
backstays. Latter part light airs
S.E. ship on port tack see nothing
Lat 38-45 Lon 162-20

Fri 21st

Fore part fine wind light E. ship
on different tack. see feed
Latter part the same as fore part
see plenty of feed and finbacks
Lat 39-04 Lon 162-28

Sat 22nd

Mr Cook



Fore part fine wind N.E. ship
on different tack. see feed
Latter part good weather wind
N.E. at 4 p.m. raised a Right whale
lowered four boats but did not
strike him, got onboard 8 p.m.
Lat 39-40 Lon 162 30

Sunday 23rd

Fore part fine, wind N.E. ship on
different tack. at 8 a.m. raised a whale
lowered 4 boats B. Boat struck and saved
one got him alongside at noon
Latter part fine wind N.E. cut
the whale in 8 u



Mon 24th

Fore part good weather wind N.E.
started the works. plenty of feed
and finbacks. Latter part wind
N.E. with some rain at 5 p.m. raised
a whale lowered 3 boats L. Boat
struck and saved one got him along
side at 6 p.m. and let him lay. got
the B. Boat in and put her in the
house to repair. got stove yesterday in
striking boiling
