Sat 4th

Fore part strong breeze E.S.E. course
S.W. by S. 1/4 S.

After part strong breeze E. course
S.W. 1/4 S. employed putting on new
gaskets and some new rigging
Lat 34-07 Lon 176-20

Sunday 5th

Fore part fine wind light from
S.E. to E. at daylight raised
Cape Brett S.W. and steered for it
After part fine, with airs from
E. to N.E. until 5 p.m. then hauled
to S.W. wore ship and stood off
on port tack Cape Brett bore
S.W. 5 miles distant

Mon 6th

Fore part light from S. to S.E.
Ship on different tacks trying to
get in. After part light airs
from E. got in up to Black Rocks
and came to anchor in 19 fathoms
of water.

Tues 7th

Fore part calm or nearly so. lay at
anchor until 7 a.m. then hove up
and towed up until 10 a.m.
then the tide turned and came to
anchor in 13 fathoms of water
After part fine. at noon got a
breeze from E. hove up anchor and
and come in off the Town of
Russells Bay of Islands N. Zealand
and dropped our anchor at 2 p.m.
in 7 fathoms of water with 4 1/2 fathom
of cable on the windless
all hands employed cleaning ship
Captain and Wife ashore

In Port Bay of Islands

Wed 8th

Fine weather to day nearly calm
employed stowing oil 61 bbls 3810 lbs.
and painting mastsheads and yards
cleaning iron work &c.

Thurs 9th

Fine today. wind S.W. light. employed
painting ship outside and aloft
and cleaning iron work

Fri 10th

This day begins with showers with light
airs from S.W. to S. employed wetting
hole and painting landed 8 coils of
towing. and a gang ashore filling water

Sat 11th

Fore part strong breeze from S.E. to E. with
rain most of the time. got the swallows boat
on shore washed off &c.
After part rain most of the time
wind E. got off a raft of water

Sunday 12th

Fore part quite a breeze S.E. squally
Starboard Watch ashore for a run
After part the same as fore part

Mon 13th

Fore part wind S.E. and squally
employed stowing water one boat crew
ashore filling water
After part wind S.E. with some rain
bent new M. J. Gallant sail and
L. J. stay sail and did a little painting
