Tues 14th

Fore part wind E. with some squalls
light employed painting and hauling
the lashings taught on the bone to ship
 Latter part fine until evening then
showery got off some potatoes and painting

Wed 15th

Fore part wind E. with fog and rain
shipped our bone home 53 bundles
got off potatoes bread and flour and a
raft of water
 Latter part wind E.S.E. with rain
bent a new U.M. topsail and filling
water

Thu 16th

Fore part strong breeze S.E. with squalls
of rain and fog. got off the last water
and bent a new L.M. topsail
 Latter part wind E.S.E. with rain
bent U.S. topsail

Fri 17th

Fore part wind S.E. and rainy
employed stowing up between decks
 Latter part wind S.S.E. strong.
bent a new L.P. topsail, discharged
Manuel De Madaris sick with
consumption has been of duty since
leaving Chatham Islands

Leave Port for Home

Sat 18th

Fore part fine wind W. light. bent a
new fore sail and painted some outside
 Latter part fine wind west light
at noon hove up our anchor and
started for home at sundown Cape Bent
fore W.S.W. 10 miles distant course E.
discharged our three Savage Island Natives
to go onboard the Bk. Triton

Sunday 19th

Fore part light air from S.W.
and W. course E.
 Latter part calm until 8 p.m.
then wind from E with rain
ship on star tack. land in
sight all day (the Four Henights)

Mon 20th

Fore part strong breeze E.N.E. ship
on port tack. no land in sight
 Latter part blowing a gale E.
ship on star tack. furled
Fore and Mizen topsails
Lat 35-14 Lon 175-41

Tues 21st

Fore part blowing strong E.
ship on star tack
 Latter part strong breeze
E. with thunder and rain
ship on differant tack
No Lat.
